Beware of Fake E-mails, Calls, Touts and Agents

It has come to the notice of JAC Delhi that some candidates are receiving fraudulent e-mails, calls, and messages from unauthorized persons claiming to facilitate admission or seat allotment in B.Tech programmes (such as CSE, IT, CSAI, and ECE) in exchange for money.

Candidates and parents are advised not to fall prey to such fraudulent claims.

Please note:

- **JAC Delhi does not send e-mails regarding seat allotment. Seat allotment results are available only through the candidate's JAC Delhi login portal.**
- The admission process is conducted **online**, with technical support from the **National Informatics Centre (NIC)**, through a **transparent, centralized, and merit-based counselling process** based solely on the candidate's **JEE (Main) Common Rank List (CRL)**.
- All official announcements, schedules, counselling information, and admission-related updates are published **only on the official JAC Delhi website: <https://jacdelhi.admissions.nic.in>**.
- Candidates should rely only on the official JAC Delhi portal and, in case of any clarification, contact the participating universities (NSUT, DTU, IIIT-Delhi, IGDTUW, and DSEU).

JAC Delhi and the participating universities shall not be responsible for any communication or financial transaction made with unauthorized persons, agents, or touts.
