- The Executive Council of the Institute may, by resolution, delegate separately to the Chairman of the Director or jointly to both of them such of its powers as it may deem fit for the conduct of business.
- The Executive Council may with prior approval of the Government after on repeal or frame new rules.

### **Powers and functions of the Executive Council**

- Subject to general control and directives of the General Council, the Executive Council shall be responsible for the management and administration of the affairs of the institute in accordance with Memorandum of Association, the rules and bye-laws made thereunder for the furtherance of the objects and shall have all powers which may be necessary expedient for the purpose including:
  - (a) To lay down broad policy to carry out the purposes of the Institute.
  - (b) To review and sanction budget estimates
  - (c) To sanction expenditure as defined in financial bye-laws
  - (d) To borrow on terms and conditions expedient.

(e) To create posts and recruit and appoint staff.

- The appointment of the Director shall be made Executive Council with the prior approval of the Government
- Creation of appointment to all such posts as carry an initial monthly pay of Rs.1600 or above, shall be done with approval of the Government.
- Creation and appointment of other posts shall be made by the Executive Council
- The Director of the Institute shall be In-charge of the Management of the Institute and shall exercise such powers in respect of the affairs of the Institute as may be delegated to him by the Executive Council from time to time
- The Executive Council may by resolution appoint one or more committee or committees or sub-committees for such purposes and with such powers as may be specified by it.
- The Executive Council of the Institute may, by resolution, delegate separately to the Chairman of the Director or jointly to both of them such of its powers as it may deem fit for the conduct of business.
- The Executive Council may with prior approval of the Government after on repeal or frame new rules.

### **Powers and Functions of the Standing Committee**

- Subject to general control and directives of the General Council, the Standing Committee shall be responsible for the management and administration of the affairs of the institute in accordance with rules and bye-laws made thereunder for the furtherance of the objects and shall have all powers which may be necessary expedient for the purpose including:
  - (a) To carry out the broad policies and objects of the Institute as set out in the Memorandum of Association or as laid down by the General Council or in accordance with such directives as the Government of India may issue to the Institute.
  - (b) To sanction expenditure for carrying out the administration of the Institute in accordance with the budget estimates approved by the General Council.
  - (c) To invest the funds of the Institute
  - (d) To create such posts as are necessary to administer the Institute and recruit and appoint staff except that the prior approval of the Government of India shall be required for the appointment to the post of Director of the Institute.
- The Standing committee may delegate such powers as it considers appropriate to the Director or other officers of the Institute.
- The Standing Committee may make bye-laws for the conduct of the business of the Institute. These shall, however, be subject to the approval of the General council.
- Without prejudice to the generality of the preceding sub-rule, the bye-laws may be made about the following:-
  - (i) Rules for admission
  - (ii) Fees and other charges in respect of training imparted to students and in respect of treatment rendered to the patients
  - (iii) Wage structure of the workshop and pricing policy of the goods manufactured in the workshop of sale.
  - (iv) Management of funds.
  - (v) Service conditions of the staff.
- Provided that the Standing Committee may with the approval of the General Council, adopt Government of India Rules and /or Regulations regarding Service Conditions of the staff, with or without modifications as may be considered necessary. This power to adopt may be exercised for a specific period or on long-term basis.

- Provided further that till such time as bye-laws as contemplated in these Rules are actually made or adopted, rules and practices in respect of matters specified above as were in force immediately prior to the registration of the Society shall remain operative and in force.
- Notwithstanding anything contained in Sub-rules 10.4 and 10.5, the Standing Committee shall make bye-laws under the aforesaid Sub-Rules in respect of the matter for which the powers to adopt Rules and/or Regulations has not been exercised within twenty four months of the registration of the Society.

- Creation of appointment to all such posts as carry an initial monthly pay of Rs.8,700/- or above, shall be done with prior approval of the Government.
- Appointment of other posts in Group A shall be made by the Executive council and the posts in Group B, C, and D by the Director of the Institute. However, creation of the plan and non-plan posts including Group A, B, C and D posts shall be done with the prior approval of the Government.
- The Director of the Institute shall be In-charge of the management of the Institute and shall exercise such powers in respect of the affairs of the Institute as may be delegated to him by the Executive Council from time to time
- The Executive Council may, by a resolution, appoint one or more Committee or Committees or Sub-Committees for such purposes and with such powers as may be specified by it.
- The Executive Council of the Institute may by resolution, delegate separately to the Chairman or the Director or jointly to both of them such of its powers as it may deem fit for the conduct of business.
- The Executive Council may with prior approval of the Government after on repeal or frame new rules.
