Minutes of the Eighth Meeting of the Governing Body under National Fund for Persons with Disabilities held under the Chairpersonship of Secretary, DEPwD – cum – Chairperson, Governing Body on 29th May, 2023 at 3:00 pm

2. Shri Rajesh Aggarwal, Secretary, DEPwD – cum – Chairperson, Governing Body welcomed the participants and requested Shri Rajesh Yadav, Joint Secretary & CEO to make a presentation on the agenda points for consideration of the Governing Body.

3. Agenda-wise decisions taken by the Governing Body (GB) is summarized below:-

3.1 Agenda 1 - Proposed new components in the existing scheme guidelines.

S.No.	New Component	Details of eligibility etc.
1.	Strengthening STEM labs for class XI, XII especially for Blind/Deaf/ID Schools under National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) and CBSE/ICSE and other Central/State school boards – having minimum 10 Children with Special Needs (CwSN) students passing class 10 th . For Inclusive schools, there should be minimum 50 CwSN, and minimum 10 PwD students passing 10 th exam	After detailed deliberations, the GB approved the following: Eligibility – • Blind/Deaf/ID Schools under National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) and CBSE/ICSE and other Central/State school boards –minimum 10 CwSN students passing class 10th • Inclusive schools - minimum 50 CwSN, and minimum 10 PwD students passing 10th exam Provision – • One time Grant-in-aid not exceeding Rs. 5 lakh or 75% of actual expenditure, whichever is less, to each of such schools (maximum 100 schools in a financial year) for creating STEM labs in classes 11th and 12th. The amount will be incurred on creation of lab facilities (building infrastructure not included). • Grant will be released in two equal installments. Second installment will be released on receipt of utilization certificates, supporting receipts, certificate from Head of the School etc.

		How to apply – • Schools under NIOS/CBSE/ICSE/other Central Boards - Proposal will be submitted to the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities. • Schools under State Boards and Inclusive Schools - Proposal will be submitted to the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities. • Head of the School will be required to submit the final bills, utilization certificates etc. within 15 days of the conclusion of the event. Approving Authority– The Governing Body shall be the competent authority to approve the proposal.
2.	Travel, boarding and lodging of athletes, coaches and escorts for participation in sports events organized by the Center for Disability Sports.	GB approved the following: Purpose – In order to popularize the Center for Disability Sports (CDS), travel, boarding and lodging of athletes with disabilities, escorts (wherever required) and coaches will be financially supported from the National Fund. Eligibility – • Financial support will be considered on recommendation of the Director, CDS. • To encourage participation of persons with disabilities, there shall be no income limit for participation in the CDS events till 31st March 2024. Governing Body will review the said time limit subsequently. • Applicant must not have obtained or applied for financial assistance for the same event from any other source. A certificate will be submitted to this effect along with the application. • Financial support will be given only once in a financial year to an individual. • Financial Assistance will initially be available only till 31st March 2024. Governing Body will

		review the said time limit subsequently. Extent of Financial Assistance – • Travel –AC 2 tier train fare. However, air travel in economy class will be allowed in case duration of the train journey is 12 hours or more. • Boarding and lodging – On actual basis or Rs 2500/- per day, whichever is less. Note - One escort will be allowed on the recommendation of the medical authority. How to apply – • Director CDS will submit the proposal to the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities. • CDS will be required to submit the final bills, utilization certificates etc. within 15 days of the conclusion of the event. Approving Authority– The Governing Body shall be the competent authority to approve the proposal.

Note: Revised Guidelines will be issued separately as per approval of the Governing Body.

It was also noted that the total budget submitted in the proposal which is a national level event is Rs. 20,75,000/-. However, the limit prescribed for the national level event in the guidelines is Rs. 20,00,000/-. Therefore, the GB approved financial grant amounting to Rs. 20 lakh or actual expenditure incurred, whichever is less, for event proposed to be held in Delhi in December 2023.

It was noted that previously India hosted the said competition in the year 2003 by the NAAI. On that occasion, Ministry of Education and Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment were also engaged with the process. The budget for the said event was reported to be Rs. 3 crore. It was informed that Sarthak Educational Trust is handling the NAAI matters. The GB further noted that since the hosting of 2003 event, new Ministries/Departments have been created such as DEPwD and Ministry

As the event also concerns other aspects in addition to the disability, it was felt that engagement of Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship and Ministry of Education in the process would be appropriate to make the event more inclusive. The GB was informed that guidelines provide for a funding of Rs. 5 crore to States /UTs for holding purple fest at national level. Taking the above into consideration, the GB recommended Rs. 5 crore or 50% whichever is less, out of total budget mentioned which is over Rs. 15 crore. It was also decided that the said financial grant will be subject to the condition that NAAI will give undertaking regarding remaining funding also. NAAI was also advised to hold consultations with Ministries of Skill Development and
