

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE SCREENING COMMITTEE HELD ON 30<sup>th</sup> AUG, 2018 TO CONSIDER NEW PROJECT PROPOSALS UNDER THE DEENDAYAL DISABLED REHABILITATION SCHEME (DDRS)**

A meeting of the Screening Committee was held on 30<sup>th</sup> August, 2018 under the Chairmanship of Dr. Prabodh Seth, Joint Secretary (DEPwD) to consider the proposals of NGOs received through State Governments for setting up new projects under Deendayal Disabled Rehabilitation Scheme (DDRS). Shri Subhash Joshi (Paliwal) and Mrs. Sushma Gupta Members of the Committee were present in the meeting.

2. The Screening Committee was informed that as per the detailed guidelines regarding streamlining the procedure for sanctioning of grant-in-aid mentioned in para 3.6.1.6 of DDRS Scheme document, the proposals duly considered and recommended by the State level Grant-in-aid Committee for supporting the voluntary organizations have to be considered by this Committee.

3. The Committee was informed that the new proposals received which are being screened and approved, may be considered for release of funds subject to receipt of recommendations/ proposals. The funds in these new cases recommended by the Committee are to be given from prospective effect only. The Committee agreed to the same.

4. A copy of the guidelines of the Scheme was provided to the Committee.

5. The Committee considered the proposals in the light of the recommendations of the State Grant-in-Aid Committee. The new project proposals were screened and approved provided they fulfill other requirements of the scheme and subject to submission of deficient documents if any, wherever it is necessary.

6. The Committee made the following general recommendations:

(i) It should be made obligatory upon all the organizations seeking grant-in-aid for running Special Schools, to submit a valid recognition/permission from concerned authority in the State Education Department and under PWD Act, 1995 or RPwD act, 2016. Further, their teaching staff should also conform to the requirements under the RCI Act.

(ii) As the Department had launched separate schemes for Skill Development and Awareness Generation, proposals under DDRS for these model projects may be submitted under the respective Schemes.

(iii) Processing of already recommended new cases in the previous and current meeting should be taken on priority on receipt of requisite documents & State Govt. Recommendations for the current year.

(iv) All the NGO's (Recommended/Deferred) are requested to be registered on NITI Aayog's NGO-Darpan portal.

(v) The NGOs( recommended or deferred) herein should be verified and checked with updated list of NGOs/voluntary organizations blacklisted/debarred/banned including from NE states by the Home Ministry and any other Department of Govt. of India and necessary action should be taken accordingly.

(vi) All the proposals kept in the Screening Committee meeting are for the year 2017-18 which were received after previous Screening Committee meeting (24.01.2018). Hence, Recommendation of this Committee for proposals of the financial year 2017-18 will be valid till the end of financial year 2018-19.

(vii) As all the proposals are for the year 2017-18, recommendations of this Screening Committee are subject to receipt of recommendation of the State Govt. 2018-19.

7. The proposals received from the following States were considered in the meeting:

- (ii) Assam
- (iii) Haryanan
- (iv) Maharashtra
- (v) Manipur
- (vi) Odisha
- (vii) Rajasthan
- (viii) Tamil Nadu
- (ix) Telangana

8. In all, 21 new cases were examined and taken up for consideration by the Screening Committee of which :


- a) 05 cases were recommended.
- b) 16 cases were not recommended.

The proposals considered by the Screening Committee along with its recommendation/remarks are contained in the Annexure.

9. Some deficiencies are found in remaining 53 proposals. The Screening Committee decided to meet again after a gap of one month so as to give sufficient time to NGOs for submission of requisite documents to be placed before it.
