2. Dr.Prabodh Seth, Joint Secretary, Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities welcomed all the participants to the meeting and briefly explained the features of Scheme/guidelines for financial assistance under the Scheme under the National Fund for Persons with Disabilities. He asked Shri K.V.S. Rao, Director to brief about the scheme and proposals received for financial assistance.

3. Shri K.V.S. Rao, Director informed the Committee that the Department received about 55 proposals seeking financial assistance under the scheme of the National Fund for Persons with Disabilities. However, most of the proposals are incomplete and certain information has been sought from the respective applicants/organizations. Out of 55 proposals, 31 proposals relate to holding exhibition/workshop to showcase the products made by PwDs, 14 proposals relate to individuals seeking financial assistance for participating in sports event, and 18 proposals relate to seeking financial assistance for customized equipments for High Supports Needs. Only 11 proposals received under the sub-category for organizing

exhibition/workshop have been placed before the Committee, as they have mostly fulfilled various requirements for considering the proposals.
