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

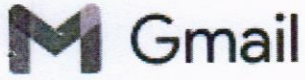
I am pleased to enclose 2nd part of recommendations:

1. Agenda 1: Sree Maa Welfare Society: The cost estimate is in order. However, the Applicant organization has not provided details of content of the booklet and purpose of organizing various awareness events. The current financial year is coming to an end, we may ask for information about the content of the booklet and purpose of arranging 8 events. We may consider this project in the next meeting.
2. Agenda 4: Rural Physically Handicapped Centre: The expenses proposed by the application are exorbitant and unrealistic. For example, spending Rs 4.5 lakhs on channel banners; Rs 1,20,000 on auto rickshaw and Resource Kit Rs 2,50,000 is truly very high and not justified. NOT RECOMMENDED
3. Agenda 5: Dhruvh Social Awareness: - Some pages are missing, I can not find the budget of the applicant.
4. Agenda 8: EDI Gandhinagar: The Applicant wishes to organize a workshop on CSR among the Coprorates. The purpose of EDII is to motivate the corporate to spend CSR funds on disability related activities. According to my understanding, this proposal does fall under the purview of Awareness Scheme. The Applicant should develop a scheme on creating awareness among the masses about the potential of people with disabilities and should invite the Corporate to events as incidental to awareness events. Organizing an event exclusively for Corporate may not fall under the purview of the Scheme. We need to discuss this matter further, hence this proposal may be considered in the next meeting
5. Agenda 9: Radio Jingle: As Hon'ble Minister has desired to develop 10 Radio Jingles, a grant of Rs 4,50,000 is recommended


