NOTE: (i) Inter-component variability may be permitted in rare conditions, but such variability should not normally exceed 5% of original estimate.


(ii) For all AGP events, the committee suggested that NI/CRC may utilize services of their own Sign Language Interpreters. Further local PwDs to be mobilized properly for participation and performance. Outside participants and performers be limited to a minimum.

(iii) Purple Fair to utilize local purple ambassadors, local artists, social media influencers & PwD anchors to the extent possible.

(iv) Care to be taken not to repeat PwDs in different Purple Fairs. Local special schools/NGOs etc. to be invited for showcasing their talent and best practices may be shared for empowerment of PwDs through panel discussion/ other engagements in the side events of Purple Fairs.


(v) All the organizations are asked to submit their detailed report considering the above points after completion of the event.

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
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
