





(iv) Care to be taken not to repeat PwDs in different Purple Fairs. Local special schools/NGOs etc to be invited for showcasing their talent and best practices may be shared for empowerment of PwDs through panel discussion/ other engagements in the side events of Purple Fairs.



(v) All the organizations are asked to submit their detailed report considering the above points after completion of the event.




