2)SAMVADA CHAPTER 45 : HOLY INFANTS' BOYS HIGH SCHOOL,VARAPUZHA(05/02/2025)

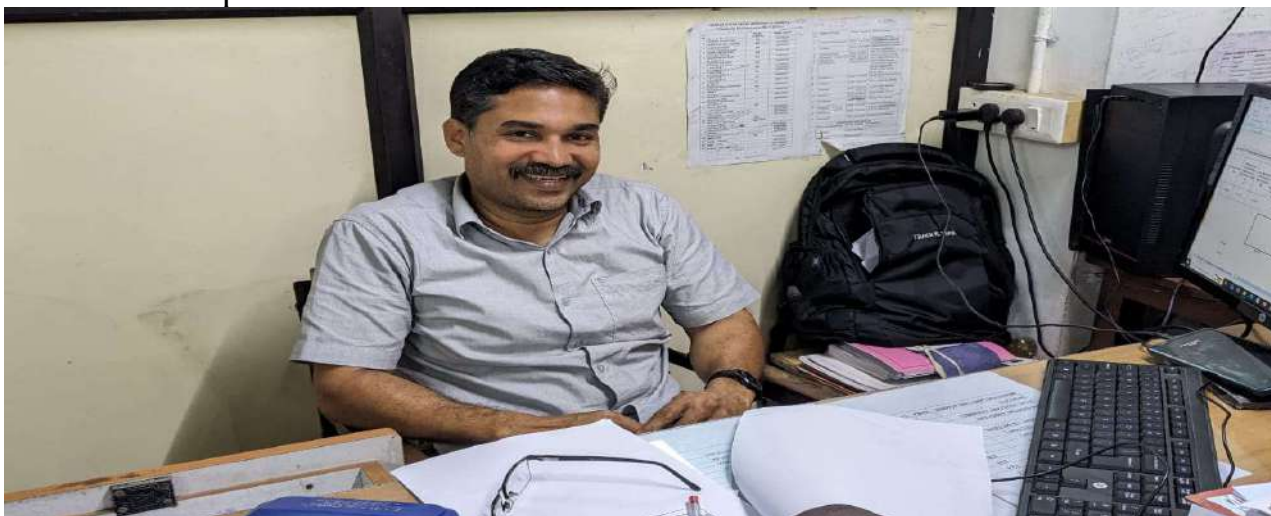
