**NOTICE**

DETAILED SCHEDULE REGARDING CONDUCT OF 2<sup>ND</sup> ROUND OF OFFLINE STATE COUNSELLING FOR VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS AND ALLOTMENT OF SEATS IN PGAC (MD/MS AYURVEDA) (CET CODE 196) IN CH. BRAHM PRAKASH AYURVED CHARAK SANSTHAN, NEW DELHI (AFFILIATED TO GGSIP UNIVERSITY) FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2022-23.

This information notice is being notified for admission in '50% State Quota Seats' in MD/MS Ayurveda only for candidates who have passed BAMS degree from GGSIP University.

The procedure for "Verification of Documents" and "2<sup>nd</sup> Round of Counselling/Allotment of seat" for the above said programme is given below:

**VENUE OF COUNSELLING: GGSIP UNIVERSITY, SEC 16C, DWARKA, NEW DELHI.**

**DATE OF COUNSELLING: 17.02.2023 (11:00 A.M.)**

1. Only the candidates who have qualified AIAPGET 2022 and have passed BAMS from GGSIP University, have registered with this University and submitted their documents for verification and preparation of merit list are only eligible to participate in this Offline Counselling for 50% seats under State/Institutional Quota.

It may please be noted that the candidates who have not qualified AIAPGET 2022 and have not registered with GGSIPU or did not submit their documents for verification and preparation of merit on the specified date & time, are not eligible to participate in the counselling for allotment of seats.

2. Tentative merit list prepared basis on the documents submitted by the registered candidates, is already uploaded on the website along with University notification no. 380/2022 dated 20.01.2023.
3. The tentative vacant seat status to be filled in Round 02 under 50% State Quota is as under:

- (I) KAYACHIKITSA – 01 (UR)
- (II) ROG NIDAN & VIKRITI VIGYAN – 01 (UR)

The final vacancy status shall be displayed at the venue on the date of counselling.

4. *The candidate has to be present in person for the purpose of verification of documents and allotment of seats as per the schedule. The candidate must produce original certificate for the purpose of verification of documents and allotment of seats.*
5. **ROSTER POINT:** A separate roster shall be followed for admission on '50% State Quota seats' conducted by GGSIP University. The roster shall be continued from roster point number where the 1<sup>st</sup> counselling was closed in the Academic Session 2022-23i.e. the Roster Point shall start from 113. However, candidates are advised to read the procedure for conduct of Round 02 counselling detailed in this schedule below.

6. SCHEDULE FOR 2<sup>ND</sup> COUNSELLING OF '50% STATE QUOTA'

1<sup>ST</sup> PHASE OF ALLOTMENT OF SEAT:

In case of vacancy arises on account of withdrawal or due to non-joining after the 1<sup>st</sup> round of counselling, the following procedure will be adopted. "From the allotted seats, from whatever roster point, the vacancy has arisen, in any particular category, then the seat shall be offered to the same category eligible candidate merit rank-wise till all eligible candidates of that category are exhausted, after which the conversion of seat shall be done as per GOI rules." In this procedure, 2<sup>nd</sup> round of Counselling will start from the roster point at which the first withdrawal comes from.

2<sup>ND</sup> PHASE OF ALLOTMENT OF SEAT:

Subsequently, the resultant vacancies so created and the unfilled vacant seats of 1<sup>st</sup> round of counselling, shall be offered to the registered candidates who had not opted or allotted any seat during the 1<sup>st</sup> Round of Counselling and also, those registered candidates, who were absent during 1<sup>st</sup> Round of Counselling but name figures in the Merit list uploaded on University website.

17.02.2023	All the REGISTERED CANDIDATES in person (irrespective of category), who have passed BAMS from the affiliated college of Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University i.e. in <u>Ch. Brahm Prakash Ayurved Charak Sansthan</u> , New Delhi and also qualified AIAPGET 2022 exam and their names appear in the Merit List displayed on University website on 20.01.23.	11:00 A.M.

Note: (1) Only the registered candidates who have passed qualifying examination i.e. BAMS from GGSIP University and submitted their documents for verification and preparation of merit list within the scheduled date & time are eligible to participate in the Offline State Quota Counselling.

(2) All the candidates, irrespective of Rank and Categories, have been called to ensure that no seat remains vacant. However, THE COUNSELLING SHALL STOP AS AND WHEN THE SEATS AER FILLED UP.

7. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

CLARIFICATION OF SCHEDULED CASTE CATEGORY CERTIFICATE:

It is seen that some SC category certificates issued by competent authority of NCT of Delhi has a clause stating that this certificate is issued on the basis of certificate of parent issued by competent authority of a State / UT other than NCT of Delhi. The benefit of reservation shall also be extended to all candidates who hold SC certificates issued from GNCTD provided such caste is enlisted in the list of Scheduled Caste as specified in Presidential Order 1951 as amended from time to time in respect of Delhi subject to fulfillment of other conditions specified therein.

Such candidates whose certificate has been issued by competent authority in GNCTD but their castes do not fall in Delhi, as specified in the Presidential Order 1951 shall not be considered for admission against seats reserved for 'Delhi Region Category'.

CLARIFICATION ON OTHER BACKWARD CLASS:

There shall be no OBC reservation in PGAC. Refer Admission Brochure 2022-23.

The reservation certificate should be in the name of the candidate seeking admission. The reservation certificate in the name either of parents (Father/Mother) is not acceptable. The name and other particulars in the reservation certificate should be identical to that in Registration form as well as in the 10<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> class certificates. Any variation in the name or other particulars in reserved category certificate may lead to refusal for admission by admission officer in the reserved category. In absence of reserved category certificate, the candidate will not be entitled for any provisional admission in reserved category on the basis of any undertaking.



The required certificate(s) for reserved categories/classes will be essential at the time of the counselling/admission and no provisional admission shall be admissible for want of caste/category certificate. Further, the caste/category certificate should invariably be in the name of the candidate himself/herself and not in favour of respective parents/guardians.

**8. ELIGIBILITY CONDITION FOR PGAC PROGRAMME:**

Candidates should have qualified BAMS. All candidates must appear in AIA-PGET 2022 conducted by AYUSH for the appropriate branch and qualify to be considered for admissions.

**NOTE:** Only the BAMS graduates passed from the medical college/institute affiliated with GGSIP University are eligible for allotment of seats under 50% State Quota (conducted by GGSIPU). The applicants who have passed BAMS from Institutes/University other than that affiliated with GGSIP University are not eligible for allotment of seats under 50% State Quota (conducted by GGSIPU).

**9. QUALIFYING MARKS/CUT OFF PERCENTILE:**

In order to be eligible for admission to PGAC, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum marks of percentile in the AIAPGET 2022 as per the minimum marks of percentile mentioned in the Central Council of Indian Medicine notification which is 50<sup>th</sup> percentile for General Category, 40<sup>th</sup> percentile for SC/ST/OBC, candidate with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49/2016), the minimum marks shall be 45<sup>th</sup> percentile for the General Category and 40<sup>th</sup> percentile for the Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and Other Backward Classes



**10. GUIDELINES FOR CANDIDATES CLAIMING RESERVATION UNDER PH/PWD CATEGORY:**

The guidelines regarding admission of students with "Specified Disabilities" under the Rights of person with disability Act, 2006 (49 of 2016) in PGAC shall be applicable as provided in the Central Council of Indian Medicine (CCIM), New Delhi notification dated 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2021 respectively available under public domain on the CCIM & CCH website.

- vii) Preference Sheet (to be filled up by the candidate) - Original
- viii) 10<sup>th</sup> Class Certificate as proof of date of birth
- ix) BAMS Degree from GGSIPU / Provisional Certificate
- x) Detailed marksheets of qualifying examinations – All Professional examination of BAMS
- xi) The compulsory internship completion certificate/proof as per the provision.
- xii) Registration Certificate from State / Central Council of Indian Medicine New Delhi / Provisional Registration Certificate
- xiii) Reserved Category Certificate (EWS/SC/ST/PWD) duly issued by the Competent Authority, as applicable.
- xiv) Character Certificate from Head of the Institution from where the qualifying examination was passed (should not be less than 06 months old).



- xv) Employer's certificate and an NOC, if employed.

12. **DATE AND TIME OF REPORTING IN THE ALLOTTED COLLEGE:**

All the candidates admitted in the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of counseling shall report in the allotted college latest by 23<sup>RD</sup> FEBRUARY, 2023


13. **Withdrawal of Admission and Refund of Fee:**
