Important:

- Admission in the Course Advanced Diploma in Child Guidance and Counselling (ADCGC), shall be done on "All India Basis", i.e., without any Regional distribution.
- Allotment of Seats will stop as and when the seats get filled up.
- A candidate belonging to any sub-category is also eligible to secure admission in General / Unreserved Category of his/her respective Region, purely on the merit of CET.
- The conversion of seats reserved for SC, ST etc. to General Category shall be done only after the completion of last counselling for the reserved categories and no such conversion will be allowed during the 1st counselling. However, while converting the seats, any unfilled seat(s) reserved for ST Category will be offered to SC Category and vice versa and only after that the conversion of the reserved category seats shall be effected.
- The provision for reservation in OBC category is not applicable for Post Graduation / Master Level programmes. However, the OBC category candidates shall claim seats in General Category in the order of their rank as per merit, as per their respective regions.

2. Seat Allocation

Seat allocation will be on the basis of seat matrix provided by the Central Government Institute or the instructions received from Govt. of India.

3. Reservation Policy

Candidates shall please refer to the Chapter 6: 'Reservation Policy', Part-A, Admission Brochure 2023-24 and as notification issued by the GGSIP University from time to time in this regard.

4. Eligibility Criteria for Programme ADCGC, CET Code-175

- 1. Any recognized Master's Degree in Social work / Psychology / Child Development / Community Resource Management / Development Communication Extension / Nursing / Special Education. OR.
- 2. M.Ed. from recognized University.
- 3. Any recognized Bachelor's Degree in Social work / Psychology / Child Development / Community Resource Management / Development Communication Extension / Nursing / Special Education with minimum 05 years of experience of working with children. OR,
- 4. B.Ed. from recognized University with minimum 04 years of experience of working with children.

The candidate must also have studied English (Elective / Core / Functional) (01 paper) at 10+2 level or higher.

5. <u>Documents Required for Verification and Allotment of Seats:</u>

- a) Bank Draft(s) of Rs. 60,000/- in favour of "Registrar, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University", payable at Delhi. The candidate will write his/her name, date of admission, phone, address, mobile no., name of the programme, CET Rank and CET Roll Number on the back of the Bank Draft(s).
- b) Four passport sized photographs (same as that in admit card).
- c) CET-2023 Admit Card in Original and CET 2023 Result.
- d) Copy of Admission verification form (Copy of Admission verification form as per Appendix 6 in Part E of Admission Brochure 2023-24).
- e) Proof of date of birth (Secondary School Mark-sheet & Certificate) (Original and Photocopy).

f) Mark-sheets / Certificates of qualifying examination:

The candidate will be required to bring the Original certificates / Mark-sheets of all the year wise or semester wise in original along with photocopy of Certificates / Mark-sheets of qualifying examination.

g) Physical Fitness Certificate:

All the students shall be required to submit a Medical Certificate indicating fitness from a Registered Medical Practitioner as per format given in Performa of Medical Certificate in given in Part-E in Admission Brochure 2023-24 (As per Appendix 5).

h) Reserved Category Certificate:

All reservation category candidates who are seeking admission in reserved category in EWS/SC/ST/DEF/PWD must bring their reservation certificate in original along with the self attested photocopy of the certificate for claiming seat against the reserved category. The Defence Category candidates, in addition, shall also bring Appendix 1 duly completed. The Appendix 1, available in Part E of Admission Brochure 2023-24.

- Conduct and Character Certificate in original from the Head of the Institution from where the qualifying examination has been passed or from Gazetted officer in Original, not more than 06 (six) months old.
- j) Application regarding age or any other relaxation with necessary approval (if necessary).
- k) The candidate claiming reservation against EWS category must produce certificate issued by the Competent Authority at the time of verification of documents and allotment of seat.
- I) Experience Certificate (original), if applicable.

NOTE:

The candidate seeking admission under reserved categories/classes has to mandatorily produce the caste/category certificate in his/her name at the time of counselling. The certificate in the name of either of the parents (Mother/Father) is not acceptable and the candidate shall not be entitled / eligible for admission against reserved seats, even on the basis of any undertaking.

6. Seat Matrix: Region wise and category wise seat matrix will be displayed at the time of counselling.

7. It will also be the sole responsibility of the candidates themselves to make sure that they are eligible and fulfill all the conditions prescribed for admission. Before filling-up the admission verification form at the time of counselling/ allotment of seats, candidate should ensure that he/she fulfills all eligibility conditions as laid down in this Admission Brochure. If it is found at any stage during the entire period of the programme that, the candidate does not fulfill the requisite eligibility conditions his/her admission will be cancelled and also disciplinary action will be initiated against him/her and the entire fee will also be forfeited.

8. Withdrawal of Admission for ADCGC Programme:

Date of Withdrawal is 28.07.2023. All the requests for withdrawal of admission, shall mandatorily be submitted in the prescribed format available in Part E, Admission Brochure 2023-24, (Appendix-11). The same shall be submitted in the Admissions Branch, Administrative Block, Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, Sector 16C, Dwarka, New Delhi - 110078.
