With references to the University notifications referred to above, it is for information to all the NEET UG 2025 qualified candidates that the process of correction/ edit window along with fresh registration and mandatory uploading of educational testimonials, reserved category documents & NEET UG 2025 score card academic session 2025-26 has already commenced.

- Candidates can correct/ edit their filled application form specifically their Category, Sub-Category and Region (passed qualifying examination i.e. class XI & XII from any school / college located in Delhi or Outside Delhi) for allotment of seat in their claimed Region/ Category/ Sub-Category. The candidates have to upload copy of their Educational Testimonials, Reserved Category Documents and NEET UG 2025 Score card.
- Uploading of documents and/or correction in online application form can be done by the candidate through his/her account login given during the registration process.
- NO PROVISIONAL ADMISSION WILL BE DONE FOR ANY RESULT AWAITED OR COMPARTMENT/SUPPLEMENTARY CASES.**
- The admitted students shall be examined by a medical board at the level of the institution for verification of NMC norms for medically fit candidates for admission. For general guidelines and certificate of reservations may see Chapter 6. The candidates must qualify NEET – UG conducted for the Academic Session.

6. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES CLAIMING RESERVATION

May please refer Chapter 6: Reservation Policy of the Admission Brochure for Bachelor's Programme 2025-26

Candidates are directed to go through the General Important Instructions for claiming the seats earmarked for various Reserved Categories uploaded on University Website vide Notification No. 30/2025, F.No.IPU-7/DI (Academic)/Misc./2025/456 dated 13.05.2025.

Candidates are also directed to go through the "Indicative Procedure for Verification of Documents of All the Allotted & Part Academic Fee Paid Candidates (Online Counselling)_Post Verification for Academic Session 2025-2026 dated 28.05.2025 uploaded on University website vide Notification No. 57/2025, F.No.GGSIPU/DI (Academic)/Misc./2025/555 dated 28.05.2025"

→The candidate seeking admission under reserved categories has to mandatorily produce the caste/category certificate in his/her name at the time of Enrollment for Online Centralized Counselling. The certificate in the name of either of the parents (Mother/Father) is not acceptable and the candidate shall not be entitled / eligible for admission against reserved seats, even on the basis of any undertaking.

→The reservation certificate should be issued from the respective state/region in which the reservation is claimed e.g. in case any candidate claims for the seat reserved for DSC/DST/DOBC category then He/She has to bring SC/ST/OBC certificate issued by Govt. of NCT of Delhi and also should have passed his/ her qualifying exam from Delhi School/College.

SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES: In reference to Chapter 6 of Admission Brochure 2025-26 and University Notification no. 16 dated 15.07.2020 as uploaded on the website i.e. www.ipu.ac.in and www.ipu.admissions.nic.in (also annexed with this notification), the candidates are hereby informed that Scheduled Caste, which are not included in the list of Scheduled Castes for Delhi, in the Presidential order, will not be entitled to admission in the University against the seats reserved for Scheduled Castes candidates of the Delhi Region. The candidates, belonging to the communities, included in the list of Scheduled Castes, in the Presidential order, in relation to Delhi will only be entitled to be considered for admission in the University, against the seats reserved for SC candidates, in terms of the Presidential order dated 20th September, 1951, as amended time to time, by the law made in this regard.

It is mandatory for the candidates to upload the required reserved categories certificate (s) at the time of the Online Registration or at the time of Online Enrolment for participation in Centralized Counselling for claiming admission in a reserved category seat and under no circumstances the request of the candidate shall be entertained for considering his/her candidature in reserved category without bonafide certificate uploaded. It is re-iterated that no provisional admission shall be admissible for want of caste/category certificate from the local competent authority. Further, the caste/category certificate should invariably be in the name of candidate himself/herself and not in favour of respective parents/guardians.

DEFENCE CATEGORY: To claim reservation of Defence Sub-Category Seat, candidates are required to mark their Sub-Category DEFENCE "YES", Otherwise candidates, who have marked their Sub-Category DEFENCE "NO" will not be able to claim reservation/allotment of seats entitled for DEFENCE Sub-Category. Further, the candidates opting for Defence Sub-Category are also required to select the

'PRIORITY' of Defence they belong to and upload the relevant APPENDIX-1, duly filled and signed by the Competent Authority, along with supporting documents, failing which their claim shall not be considered as valid.

PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES (PWD): All the candidates who furnish PWD certificate from any Government Hospital/ Unique Disability ID issued by the Government of India having minimum disability of 40% under the provisions of 'The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act - 2016, shall be eligible for claiming reservation on Delhi and Outside Delhi seats. Reservation of seats for persons with benchmark disabilities is open to all specified categories.

ARMY: The admission to the ACMS is for the children of eligible serving Army personnel, Ex Army personnel and war widows/widows of the Army. Children of Air Force, Navy and Paramilitary forces like CRPF, BSF, ITBP, CISF, Assam Rifles, GREF and DSC are not eligible for the admission in ACMS against the seats reserved for wards / widows of the army personnel's. To claim reservation specifically for seats of 'ARMY', candidates, are required to select 'INDIAN ARMY' option and upload Appendix 9(A)/9(B)/9(C), whichever is applicable.

ECONOMICALLY WEAKER SECTION (EWS): Implementation of 10% reservation of Economically Weaker Sections, as per letter no. F.DHE.1(119)/Estt./2318- 19/2549-76 dated 17.06.2019 in terms of OM No. F No. 12-4/2319-U1 dated 17.01.2019 issued by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education in this respect to give effect to the provision of the Constitution (One Hundred and third Amendment) Act, 2019 for all higher educational institutions funded/aided, directly, or indirectly, by the Government of NCT of Delhi. The candidates shall be granted admission in EWS category subject to fulfillment of all the conditions as per rules of Govt.

Note:


1. Reservation for EWS category is applicable only in University School of Studies and Govt. Colleges affiliated with GGSIP University only. This will be implemented in accordance with the Govt. of India and Govt. of NCT of Delhi orders as applicable.
2. Reservation for EWS category is applicable for Un-reserved Category Candidate only. SC/ST/OBC category candidates will not be considered for reservation under EWS Category.
3. EWS Certificate should be issued after 31st March, 2025 stating valid for year 2025-26.

OTHER BACKWARD CLASS (OBC): 27% seats are reserved only for candidates holding "OBC CERTIFICATE (DELHI)", i.e. OBC Certificate issued to original residents of Delhi prior to 1993 belonging to the list of OBC castes in Delhi issued by Competent Authority of Delhi. The reservation will be available only in the University Schools of Studies and other Government Institutions. Students will be admitted in this category on the submission of a certificate to this effect from the Competent Authority of the Government of NCT of Delhi. Certificate issued for "Applying for appointment to posts under Govt. of India" or issued by any other state government will not be accepted under any circumstances. "OBC CERTIFICATE" issued by a Competent Authority of Delhi to an individual on the basis of OBC Certificate of his/her parents from another state will not be accepted for claiming a seat under OBC Category. Reservation in OBC Category is not applicable for Master's Level and Postgraduate Diploma programmes. The non-creamy layer certificate should be issued after 31st March, 2025. It is mandatory to submit the Non-Creamy Layer Certificate issued after 31st March, 2025 for claiming Reservation against OBC Category in addition to valid OBC Certificate.

NOTE: At the time of document verification of reserve category document, if the document verification officer raises any query, the candidate must respond in online mode (through candidate's portal) within the stipulated time. Failure to respond to the query (ies) on time will lead to cancellation of the allotted seat and forfeiture of his/her right to claim reserved category and shall be considered as a General Category Candidate for allotment of seat in the subsequent round.



8. Candidates must have secured the minimum required Cut Off percentile and score as per NMC/DCI/NCISM regulations.

THE CONSTITUTION (SCHEDULED CASTES) ²[(UNION TERRITORIES)] ORDER 1951
C.O. 32

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 341 of the Constitution of India, as amended by the Constitution (First Amendment) Act, 1951, the President is pleased to make the following Order, namely:—

1. This Order may be called the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) ²[(Union Territories)] Order, 1951.

2. Subject to the provisions of this Order, the castes, races or tribes or parts of, or groups within, castes or tribes, specified in ³[Parts I to III] of the Schedule to this Order shall, in relation to the ²[(Union territories)] to which those parts respectively relate, be deemed to be Scheduled Castes so far as regards members thereof resident in the localities specified in relation to them respectively in those Parts of that Schedule.

⁴[3. Notwithstanding anything contained in paragraph 2, no person who professes a religion different from the Hindu, ⁵[the Sikh or the Buddhist] religion shall be deemed to be a member of a Scheduled Caste.]

⁶[4. Any reference in this Order to a Union territory in Part I of the Schedule shall be construed as a reference to the territory constituted as a Union territory, as from the first day of November, 1956, any reference to a Union territory in Part II of the Schedule shall be construed as a reference to the territory constituted as a Union territory as from the first day of November, 1966 and any reference to a Union territory in Part III of the Schedule shall be construed as a reference to the territory constituted as a Union territory as from the day appointed under clause (b) of section 2 of the Goa, Daman and Diu Reorganisation Act, 1987.]
