Rajasthan govt seeks viability survey for seaplane service in Udaipur, Banswara, Kota, and Tonk: Jaipur, Jul 10 : The Rajasthan Government is keen in exploring prospects of launching the Sea-plan service at some places, including Udaipur, Banswara, Kota and Tonk. The state government has requested the Centre for undertaking study - survey for exploring viability of this service and also for including it under the Regional Connectivity Service (RCS), an official communique stated. This prospects-viability of the service may be ascertained along the Lakes of Udaipur, the Mahi along Banswara, the Chambal river in Kota and the Bisalpur dam in Deoli-Tonk, Rajasthan Civil Aviation Minister Gautam Dak said in the communique. Dak said "The state government has brought the state's Civil Aviation Policy in 2024. This policy aims at well planned and sustainable development of the above remote regions of the state."

# Kharge slams BJP govt over Gujarat bridge collapse

Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge Thursday strongly criticised the BJP

government over the recent bridge collapse in Gujarat which claimed 16 lives.

In a post on handle X, he expressed condolences to the families of the victims and questioned the government's

handling of infrastructure projects. "Accidents have become a routine affair in the country. Sometimes it's a rail accident, sometimes a bridge develops cracks right after its inaugu-

Citing the frequency of accidents and infrastructure failures in the country, Kharge pointed out that the Gujarat bridge collapse was the seventh such incident in the state since 2021. He said the bridge collapse highlights the government's lack of attention to infrastructure safety.

"This is a result of leadership crisis, rampant corruption, lack of capacity to govern, and incompetence. We hope the people of the country are watching this and will respond appropriately when the time comes," he said, accusing the BJP government of negligence and incompetence. Citing the frequency of

accidents and infrastructure failures in the country, Kharge pointed out that the Gujarat bridge collapse was the seventh such incident in the state since 2021. He said the bridge collapse highlights the government's lack of attention to infrastructure safety. Kharge expressed the hope that the public would take note of the government's failures and respond accordingly in the future. The Congress leader's remarks come amid growing concerns over infrastructure safety and governance in the country.

## Maha House passes amended Bill to check illegal activities of Left-Wing Extremists

The Maharashtra Legislative Assembly on Thursday passed by voice vote the Maharashtra Special Public Security Bill, 2024, tabled by Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis as per the joint select committee's report.

The bill, which was presented in the winter session last year, was referred to the revenue minister Chandrashekhar Bawankule-led joint select committee, which suggested amendments in its report.

The revised bill presented by the chief minister aims to prevent certain unlawful activities of left-wing extremist organisations or similar organisations. There has been no dissent note in the joint select committee report. The CPM member Vinod Nikola had opposed the bill.

CM Fadnavis strongly defended the tabling of the amended bill, saying that it is not to harass anyone, but it is against those who incite people against the Indian Constitution. No action can be taken against any journalist or political leader. The bill is for the security of the country, the state and against those who want to declare war against the Indian Constitu-

tion. Fadnavis clarified that the bill is not against a party pursuing left ideology. It is not against left parties to function. The bill has nothing to do with left parties like CPI and CPM, and the government respects their leaders. He clarified that the bill is not against individuals but against the organisation, saying that organisations representing farmers and others have the right to take morchas, and they will not attract action under the bill.

As per the amendment suggested by the joint select committee, earlier the bill was called "A Bill to prevent illegal activities of individuals and organisations", but it has now been amended to read as "A Bill to prevent illegal activities of extremist, left-wing extremist organisations or similar organisations".

As per the amendment suggested by the joint select committee, the bill proposes the establishment of the advisory board, which will declare a particular organisation as unlawful, will have a working High Court justice or retired justice, a retired district judge and a public prosecutor of the High Court. The high court justice or retired justice will be the chairperson of the committee.

## Bihar CM expands 35 per cent quota for women in govt jobs across all roles

After granting 35 per cent reservation to women candidates who are native residents of Bihar in all direct recruitment processes across the state, Chief Minister Nitish Kumar today announced that this reservation will also extend to contractual and outsourced positions, ensuring that native women benefit from this policy irrespective of the employment model.

Reiterating his commitment to women's empowerment and fostering their active and positive participation in society, the Chief Minister said that this reservation will be applicable with immediate effect, to all levels and types of government posts under every

category and service in the state. In a message posted on 'X', he said: "Currently, the recruitment process is underway for 1,51,579 vacant government positions across Bihar. The newly introduced reservation policy will be applicable throughout this recruitment drive, including across various phases of selection. Importantly, it will also extend to contractual and outsourced positions, ensuring that native women benefit from this policy irrespective of the employment model."

He added: "All government departments have been instructed to expedite the process of filling existing vacancies so that the state's youth—especially women—can benefit from the opportunities."

## Shinde Sena MLA defends slap, says South Indians destroyed Maharashtra with ladies dance bars

The Deputy CM Eknath Shinde-led Shiv Sena MLA Sanjay Gaikwad, who brutally beat up the canteen manager for serving stale food at the Akashwani MLAs' hostel canteen, has defended slapping a hostel canteen manager and also stated here on Thursday, that he has no regrets for his action.

"It was only after my beating that the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) cancelled the license of the canteen which served substandard food to the people. My method may have been wrong, but my reaction was not wrong," Shinde Sena MLA Sanjay Gaikwad, who questioned why the opposition is so fond of the MLA hostel canteen manager who is a South Indian.

"The opposition has criticised me for the beating, but I must tell them that Maharashtra was destroyed by people from South India. All the ladies service bars and dance bars which Shetty people from South India ruin, ruined the youth and spoiled the culture of Maharashtra. Whatever I did, I did for the people of Maharashtra. So why is the opposition so fond of South Indians," Sanjay Gaikwad asked opposition MLAs.

Shinde-led Shiv Sena MP Sanjay Gaikwad's statement has come at a time when the Indian Hotels & Restaurants Association (AHAR) President Sudhakar Shetty, in less than a year, Value Added Tax (VAT) on liquor was doubled from 5 per cent to 10 per cent, followed by a 15 per cent hike in licence fees for fiscal 2025-

2026, and a staggering 60 per cent increase in state excise duty.

"All taken together, these multiple tax blows have made the hospitality business unsustainable, especially considering that we are still reeling under the economic aftershocks of the Covid-19 pandemic shutdowns. Roughly, 50 per cent of the hotel owners and workers hail from Karnataka. This is not just an economic blow, but a potential death knell to an industry which contributes significantly to employment, state taxes and the national economy. These draconian hikes are akin to the final nail in the coffin of the hospitality sector," AHAR President Sudhakar Shetty said.
