Sub : Clubbing of Common Entrance Test for the programme B.PT/B.OT (Code 119) and BASLP/BPO/B.MLS (Code 124)

It is informed that the University released the Admission Brochures for Bachelor's/Master's programmes on 28.1.2026 and started the Online Registration process from 1st February, 2026. The submission of Online Application; initially, included admission in programme B.PT/B.OT Programme through the merit of NEET UG 2026, in addition to admission through the CET (to be conducted by the University) for these programmes. It is informed that the admissions in B.PT / B.OT through NEET UG were originally included in the Admission Brochure on the directions of National Commission for allied and Healthcare Professions, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India.

Subsequently, National Commission for allied and Healthcare Professions, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, Letter; File No. Z-1011/2026/NCAHP(AHS)/FTS No. 126 dated 02.03.2026 notified that the admission process for Bachelor of Physiotherapy (B.PT) and Bachelor of Occupational Therapy (B.OT) Under-Graduate programme's mandatory requirement of appearance in NEET (UG)-2026 examination be deferred till next academic year 2027-28.

Taking cognizance of this deferment Notice from the said Council, it was decided that the University will not carry out admission in Bachelor of Physiotherapy (B.PT) and Bachelor of Occupational Therapy (B.OT) through the merit of NEET UG 2026. And, the portal for submission of online application form for admission in B.PT and B.OT (through NEET UG 2026) was withdrawn. Candidates who had filled up online application form for admission in B.PT and B.OT (through NEET UG 2026), will be considered as 'applied' for admission in B.PT and B.OT (through CET).

In view of this, all the stakeholders are hereby informed that the University shall be carrying out / clubbing the two CETs i.e. Code 124 (for the programmes BASLP/BPO/B.MLS) and Code 119 (for the programmes B.PT/B.OT). It is further informed that the Common Merit List (Rank) will be displayed by the University for these CETs. However, the admissions will be done on the basis of laid down eligibility conditions in the Admission Brochure and subsequent Notice(s), if any.

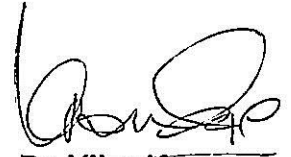
