PREAMBLE:-

Due to lack of adequate facilities for rehabilitation of Persons with Disabilities, the Ministry has set up multiple Composite Regional centers for Persons with Disabilities in different States to provide both preventive and promotional aspects of rehabilitation like education, health, employment and vocational training, research and manpower development, rehabilitation for persons with disabilities etc. CRC Nagpur was established with the aim to rehabilitate and empower persons with disabilities of Maharashtra.

Composite Regional Centre for Skill Development, Rehabilitation & Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (CRC-NAGPUR) is service institution set up under Administrative Control of Ali Yawar Jung National Institute of Speech & Disabilities (Divyangjan) (AYJNISHD) (D), Mumbai, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India with aim of Creating & Developing Resources, Infrastructure & Services required for Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) in the State of Maharashtra. There are National Institutes and other apex bodies in each area of disability in different parts of India under the same Ministry. The ministry has set up CRCs in different parts of India. CRC at Nagpur has become functional since October 2015. Currently CRC-Nagpur is functioning under the Administrative Control of Ali Yawar Jung National Institute of Speech & Disabilities (Divyangjan) (AYJNISHD) (D), Mumbai, Apart from undertaking centre based, camp based rehabilitation, awareness generation, academic & service provision activities it also functions as apex resources centre for Persons with Disabilities (PwDs).

OBJECTIVES:-

- To undertake public education programme for creation of awareness in community regarding PWDs.
- To establish linkage with state & district administration and non- government organizations.
- To stimulate growth of services in the field of rehabilitation by encouraging and supporting organizations, parents, groups, self-help groups etc.
- To develop strategies for delivery of rehabilitation services.
- To provide therapeutic services for PwDs, especially children, through early intervention.
- To act as a nodal agency for vocational training and placement of PwDs.
- To provide more number of qualified professionals in the field of rehabilitation of PwDs by conducting RCI accredited programmes for different categories of disabilities.
- To function as a consultancy / advocacy agency for the Government, Non – Government Institutions in the field of disability rehabilitation.
- Provisions of assistive devices to persons with disabilities.
- To undertake research & development.

ADIP Summary

Assistance to Disabled Persons for Purchase /Fitting of Aids and Appliances (ADIP Scheme):

The main objective of the scheme is to assist needy persons with disabilities in procuring durable sophisticated and scientifically manufactured, modern, standard aids and appliances that can promote their physical, social and psychological rehabilitation by reducing the effects of disabilities and enhance their economic potential. Aids and appliances which do not cost less than Rs. 50 and not more than Rs. 6,000 are covered under the scheme.





Inauguration of P&O Unit

The Composite Regional Centre (CRC) for Skill Development, Rehabilitation & Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan) is the regional level institute under DEPwD of Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment Govt. of India. CRC Nagpur was established in 2015 and is functional under AYNISHD (D) Mumbai. Since its inception, CRC Nagpur has been serving persons with disabilities with a life cycle approach. The services range from prevention to early identification intervention, aids and appliances education, and therapeutics and skill development.

With most of the departments established earlier, CRC Nagpur inaugurated P &O Unit for fabrication of appliances specially orthosis. These aids will help the beneficiaries for early rehabilitation as they can approach department directly for new orthosis along with the repair work needed.





- **BEST PRACTICES OF THE DEPARTMENT**

Team CRC provides Early Intervention services and screening services at the Pediatric Department of Indira Gandhi Government Medical College and Hospital (IGGMC), Nagpur.

Children under age 18 years are screened and are identified for Disability. Services like physiotherapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy & special education services are provided to the identified children with disability. Screening of the neonates and children further aims towards primary and secondary prevention of disability by making the parents aware about the normal developmental milestones, early intervention, therapies, rehabilitation and home activities & plans. High risk Neonates are screened once a week for Hearing Loss by means of Oto acoustic Emissions test (OAE). Those failing the screening are then referred for BERA testing & further management.

Approval taken for Extra Building from NMC Nagpur for running the RCI approved courses at CRC Nagpur: -

After regular follow ups and meetings with The Hon'ble Mayor & NMC higher officials, we were able to get approval from the NMC for the allotment of extra building for running the RCI approved academic courses. But the NMC decided to take 10% rent of this building which was around Rs.42000/- a month. This building is around 05 Km away from our present office.

We put up the proposal in the EC for approval. But the EC did not approve the proposal because of its huge rent and far distance from our present office. So the EC Suggested CRC Nagpur to focus on Clinical services and STTPs training programmes and the EC suggested that the courses will be started once the own building of CRC Nagpur gets constructed.

GLIS land Data Uploaded Successfully on Google Maps: -

We coordinated with the concerned department at Ministry and completed successfully the Uploading of GLIS land Data on the Google maps of our allotted land for construction of CRC Nagpur building.

Construction of Boundary Wall & Main Gate: -

Boundary wall work is 65% completed, but now the work is again started by the CPWD which was stopped due COVID-19 and rainy season as our allotted land become

marshy/filled with water due to the rainy season. It is expected that work will be finished by 31st January 2021.

Removal of Trees from the Land site: -

Total 95 trees removed from the Land site successfully, it was one of the major task for the land development of CRC Nagpur as tree cutting is a very sensitive issue in Nagpur.

Construction of the Building of CRC Nagpur: -

A huge amount of Tax has been put on our allotted land by the NMC, which is the major liability on us around 1.32Cr. per year, which is equal to the annual budget of CRC itself. So it is a very crucial to take further approvals for the construction of building. We had a several meetings with the NMC commissioner regarding tax exemption on land which is further under process at the level of the Chief Secretary, Government of Maharashtra. So waiver of tax and the construction of the building, which is the first priority of CRC Nagpur.

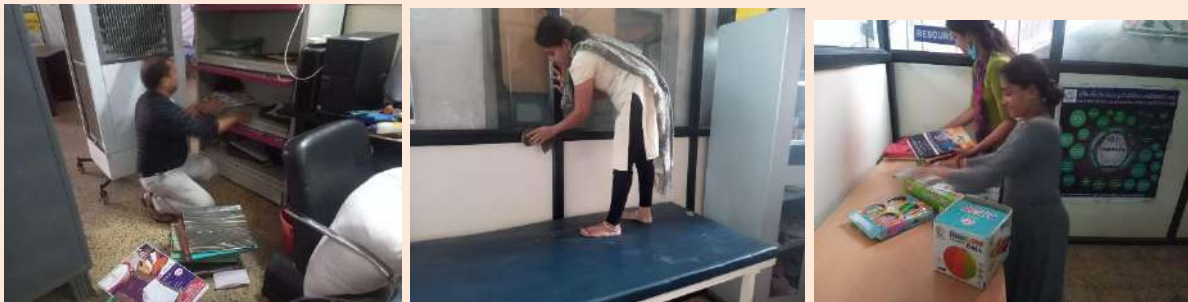


6. Swchha Bharat Abhiyaan 2021

World Autism Awareness Day (WAAD) is celebrated all over the world every year to raise the awareness about people living with autistic spectrum disorders, including autism and Asperger syndrome, among the community and helping them for their inclusion in the society as a normal person and not to consider it as a disease, but disorder which can be corrected to equally normal level with early intervention and diagnosis.

Theme for World Autism Awareness Day 2021 as per United Nations is 'Inclusion in the Workplace: Challenges and Opportunities in a Post-Pandemic World'. Dr Aparna Bhalerao, Head, Department and Assistant Professor, Department of Clinical

Psychology, CRC Nagpur explained the meaning of the theme and expressed confidence that, the society would definitely become aware of this disorder. As per United Nations version, 'Persons with autism have long faced many of these

inequalities, which have only been further exacerbated by the pandemic, it's a problem made worse by long recognized discriminatory hiring practices and workplace environments that present major obstacles for persons with autism; all of which contribute to the unemployment or severe underemployment of a large majority of adults on the autism spectrum," said Dr Bodhanekar.

According to the 2011 Census of India, there are 76.62.521 children with disabilities below the 19-year age group in the

country, among which 5,95,089 have an intellectual disability. A study done by INCLEN Trust International in 2018 says about 1 in 100 children in India under age 10 has autism, and nearly 1 in 8 has at least one neurodevelopmental condition, informed Dr Bodhanekar.
