It has been brought to the notice of the Govt. that in some of the Districts when there was a provision for widening and black topping of roads, the practice followed was to first black top the central 12' width and then carryout widening as a subsidiary work. This practice should be discouraged. The field Officers are, therefore, requested to ensure that whenever black topping is to be done on a widened surface, the widened surface is completed to the required standard first and then only black topping should be done for the full widened surface in one operation.

These instructions should be strictly followed in future.
