Background & Problem Statement

The Connectivity Gap at Lohape Nehalpada

- **Location:** Kelthan Dakivali Road (MDR 42) at Km 30/000 to 31/200 ,
- Taluka Wada, District -Palghar
- **The Problem:** Previously, there was no adequate Connectivity.
- **Impact:** The said road used to deteriorate severely during the monsoon season, developing a large number of potholes, which caused major inconvenience and safety issues for road users.
- **Necessity:** Permanent infrastructure was required for proper connectivity and Mobility of traffic .
