

Bar Association

The legal practitioners of the district have organized themselves into the bar association, Sultanpur which is a registered organization. It was established in 1921. It has a library, a reading room and a recreation room club for its members. The chief aims of the association are to promote the welfare of the members of the bar to maintain harmonious relation between the bench and bar, to foster respect for national and international laws and encourage their study and to remain in touch with the bar association of other districts and the bar council of the state. The membership of the association on May 31, 1972 was 232. Sri. Vinda Prasad Srivastava was the first Chairman of the Bar Association. Shri Ganpat Sahai an eminent lawyer was torch bearer of freedom movement. He was later elected as member of Vidhan Sabha and Lok Sabha. Former Justice Ram Pyare Shukla was an eminent practitioner at Bar. He was later elevated to Hon'ble High Court, Allahabad. Sri Sripati Mishra, an advocate and retired judge later became chief minister of Uttar Pradesh during the period of 1982-84.
