As per the latest amendment in the Government of India (Allocation of Business) Rules, 1961, the Department of Economic Affairs has been entrusted the work related to "legislation relating to bankruptcy and insolvency". The Insolvency and Bankruptcy Bill has been introduced in the Lok Sabha during the last session of Parliament and has been referred to the Joint Parliamentary Committee. The Bill is in the priority item of the Government and is likely to be taken up during the Budget session.

The Bill proposes that Debts Recovery Tribunals will be the Adjudicating Authority for individual's and unlimited liability partnership firms. In view of the additional work to be entrusted to the Debts Recovery Tribunals (DRTs), this Department will have to consider establishing additional DRTs based on the number of cases of bankruptcy and insolvency pending with various courts.

In order to assess the number of DRTs to be established, this Department requires district wise pendency of bankruptcy and insolvency cases in Munsif Courts, District Courts and appeals pending before Districts and High Courts (where Provincial Insolvency Act, 1920 is applicable). Further, the pendency data for insolvency cases pertaining to Mumbai, Kolkata and Chennai Commissionerates (where Towns Presidency Insolvency Act, 1909 is applicable) may also be provided.
