

Resolution of the meeting dated 26.07.2022 of the Selection Board of the establishment of Special Judge CBI & NIA Assam Guwahati

A meeting of the Selection Board was held today dated 26.07.2022 at 5: 30 PM, in the Chamber of the Special Judge, CBI & NIA Court, Assam and was attended by the Special Judge, CBI & NIA Court, Assam, Civil Judge-cum-Assistant Judge No.1, Kamrup (M) and Munsiff No.3, Kamrup (M), Guwahati.

The agenda for the meeting was taking forward the process of selection for the post of Sheristadar in the establishment of Special Judge, CBI & NIA Court, Assam.

In this regard, pursuant to **advertisement dated 04.05.2022** inviting applications for the post of Sheristadar / Chief Administrative Officer in the establishment of Special Judge, CBI, Assam, Guwahati, **5 (five) applications were received** from candidates namely, **Md. Piranur Ali**, (*Bench Clerk G-I, POCSO Court, Nalbari*), **Sh. Ranjit Kalita** (*UDA/ In-Charge Sheristadar of Special Judge, CBI & NIA court, Assam*), **Sh. Samindra Nath Kakati** (*Head Assistant, Addl. CBI Court No. 3*), **Sh. Dipu Mani Kalita** (*Head Assistant, Addl. CBI Court No. 2*), **Sh. Partha Pratim Sarma** (*In-Charge Sheristadar, District & Sessions Judge establishment, Hojai*).

The Rules governing the field are the *Assam District & Sessions Judges Establishment (Ministerial) Service Rules, 1987*. Rule 6 of the said Rules stipulates the eligibility criteria for the post Sheristadar. It lays down that the post of Sheristadar may be filled up by promotion from amongst Head Assistant or Sheristadar of Additional District Judge, having experience of 5 (five) years in the aforesaid posts. Rule 16 of the Rules also provides for relaxation in appropriate cases.

As per the advertisement, the applicants were to be called for an interview. It was decided that 10 marks were to be allotted to the interview. Assessment out of another 20 marks was to be made, out of which weightage for seniority was to be 10 marks and weightage for service record, experience etc. was to be 10 marks. Thus, total assessment was to be out of 30 marks. Each member of the Selection Board is to award marks and average thereof is to be taken. The relaxation clause prescribed under Rule 16 was incorporated in the advertisement

Upon perusing the applications, the candidates were directed to submit copies of the ACRs, Service Book and Character Roll, if any, of recent years.

On 05.07.2022, the Selection Board interviewed all the five candidates and marked them accordingly. The same is re-produced herein below:

Amongst the candidates, Sri Dipu Mani Kalita is found to be the senior most, as per the records and materials submitted, the said senior most person is given marks of 10 (ten) and the other four candidates who are junior to him are marked accordingly.

For the purpose of assessing the service record etc., the documents pertaining to the same submitted by the candidates are perused, such as ACRs, Service Book etc. As per the rules applicable, the eligibility for the post of Sheristadar is 5 (five) years in the post of Head Assistant or Sheristadar of Addl. District Judge. Candidate Sh. Partha Pratim Sarma {*In-Charge Sheristadar, District & Sessions Judge establishment, Hojai*} is working in the rank of Sheristadar of Civil Judge; Md. Piranur Ali is working in the rank of Bench Clerk G-I in POCSO Court Nalbari.

Out of the other three candidates, Sri Dipu Mani Kalita has been working as Head Assistant in Addl. CBI Court No. 2 since 16.09.2021 and Sh. Samindra Nath Kakati has been working as Head Assistant in the Court of Addl. CBI Court No. 3 since 06.09.2017. Sh. Ranjit Kalita belongs to the cadre of UDA and as the senior most UDA in the establishment, has been holding the post of Sheristadar in the establishment of Special Judge, CBI & NIA since 2015 (21.09.2015).

It may be mentioned herein that the post of Head Assistant has not been created for the establishment of Special Judge, CBI & NIA so far, though a proposal for the same, upon being approved by the Hon'ble High Court, is pending with the Judicial Department, Govt. of Assam. The Selection Board is of the view that though the said candidate Sh. Ranjit Kalita does not formally hold the post of Head Assistant, he cannot be penalized for the same, as the said post does not even exist in the concerned establishment and law does not compel a person to do the impossible. In such view of the matter, the experience of Sh. Ranjit Kalita as In-Charge Sheristadar since 2015, has to be seen as similar to the experience of Dipu Mani Kalita and Samindra Nath Kakati, in their capacities as Head Assistant of Addl. CBI Court No. 2 and 3 respectively.

Further, in the said situation, as far as the length of such similar experience is concerned, such experience of Sh. Ranjit Kalita is found to be almost 7 years, which is longer than such similar experience of the other two candidates mentioned above. The Selection Board has also taken note of the fact that such experience of candidate Sh. Ranjit Kalita is pertaining to the establishment of Special Judge, CBI & NIA regarding which selection has to be made for the post of Sheristadar. The Selection Board is of the considering view that considering the long years of service rendered

by Sri Ranjit Kalita in that establishment, including as In-charge Sheristadar since 2015, it is also a fit and deserving case to invoke Rule 16 in his favour, in the interests of justice.




Upon perusing the comparative chart of marks of the candidates, for all the three categories, the total aggregate marks of candidate Sri Ranjit Kalita is found to be the highest {21.82 marks out of 30}, taking the average of marks given by all the three Members of the Selection Board.

Accordingly, the Selection Board hereby recommends **Sri Ranjit Kalita** for promotion / appointment to the post of Sheristadar in the establishment of Special Judge, CBI & NIA, Assam, Guwahati.

the said two Office Notes are made seen today by members of the Selection Board. Copies of the same may be tagged with this resolution.



Resolution of the meeting dated 17.12.2021 of the Selection Board of the establishment of Special Judge CBI & NIA Assam Guwahati

A meeting of the Selection Board was held today dated *17.12.2021 at 5 PM*, in the Chamber of the Special Judge CBI & NIA Assam Guwahati and was attended by the Special Judge, CBI & NIA Court, Assam; Civil Judge-cum-Assistant Judge No.1, Kamrup (M) and Munsiff No.3 Kamrup (M).

The agenda for the meeting was selection for the post of Sheristadar and also one post of Peon (Grade IV), lying vacant in this establishment.

The Selection Board has perused the earlier Resolution dated 25.03.2021 regarding selection of Sheristadar. The Board has perused the *Assam District & Sessions Judges Establishment (Ministerial) Service Rules, 1987*. Rule 6 of the said Rules stipulates the eligibility criteria for the post Sheristadar. It lays down that the post of Sheristadar may be filled up by promotion from amongst Head Assistant or Sheristadar of Additional District Judge, having experience of 5 (five) years in the aforesaid posts. Rule 16 of the Rules also provides for relaxation in appropriate cases.

For the post of Sheristadar, advertisement will be issued calling for applications from interested candidates fulfilling the criteria, working in the different Court establishments of Assam. The candidate should be a Graduate. The advertisement shall be properly notified through e-mail, website, notice board, including a brief newspaper publication in 2 local dailies – English and Assamese. *The applicants shall be called for an interview. It is decided that 10 marks will be allotted to the interview.*

Assessment out of another 20 marks would be made, out of which weightage for seniority would be 10 marks and weightage for service record, experience etc. would be 10 marks. Thus, total assessment would be out of 30 marks. Each member of the Selection Board shall award marks and average thereof will be taken. As a matter of abundant precaution and for wider choice, the relaxation clause prescribed under Rule 16 can be incorporated in the advertisement so that the selection process to fill up the vacant post does not fail due to any non-availability of candidates satisfying the full criteria. Each candidate has to submit 2 (two) character certificates from 2 (two) responsible persons, not related to the candidate. Applications for Sheristadar shall be received by hand in office or by email in office email (cbicourtpanbazar@gmail.com) or by post.


For the post of Peon (Grade IV), advertisement will be issued calling for applications from interested candidates fulfilling the criteria. The candidate should have passed Class VIII and not passed Class XII. In this regard, perused *Notification No. HC. XI-06/2015/67/RC dated 28.01.2016* issued by the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court. The age criteria shall be as per the standard guidelines of the Govt of Assam and the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court.

The advertisement shall be properly notified through website, notice board and newspaper publication in 2 local dailies – English and Assamese. *The applicants shall be called for an interview / viva voce and selection will be by such interview / viva voce. It is decided that 30 marks will be allotted to such interview / viva voce.* Each member of the Selection Board / Interview Board shall award marks out of total 30 marks and average thereof will be taken. In case, any interview board member has

to recuse for any candidate, the average of the marks given by the other members shall be taken. Applications for Peon shall be received by drop box in office as well as by post. No application fee will be necessary. In the event of more than one candidate securing the highest mark in Peon interview, the Selection Board reserves the right to work out a suitable criterion for final selection, including, if necessary, additional round of interview / viva voce of the candidates securing the same highest mark.







Vide this application, he has prayed that he may be considered for promotion to the post of Sheristadar.

The Board has perused the *Assam District & Sessions Judges Establishment (Ministerial) Service Rules, 1987*. Rule 6 of the said Rules stipulates the eligibility criteria for the post Sheristadar. It lays down that the post of Sheristadar may be filled up by promotion from amongst Head Assistant or Sheristadar of Additional District Judge, having experience of 5 (five) years in the aforesaid posts. Rule 16 of the Rules also provides for relaxation in appropriate cases.

The Selection Board has taken notice of the fact that though the Rules are silent about advertisement, but the general convention which has emerged over the last several years is to go for at least one advertisement so as to enable eligible candidates working in different Court establishments of Assam to participate in such selection.

After due deliberations, the members of the Selection Board were of the unanimous opinion that there should be an advertisement for the post of Sheristadar in this establishment based on the aforesaid principles. The Selection Board is also of the opinion that the application of Sri Ranjit Kalita, UDA for promotion cannot be considered in the present form, but that he may also participate in selection process if so desired.

The details of the advertisement and the modalities of the selection process shall be worked out and finalized in a subsequent meeting of the Selection Board. As a matter of abundant precaution and for wider choice, the relaxation clause prescribed under Rule 16 can be incorporated in the advertisement so that the selection process to fill up the vacant post does not fail due to any non-availability of candidates satisfying the full criteria. 
