

In the light of Hon'ble Court's order, there will be only one G.R. register which will be maintained by the office of C.J.M. wherein entries of all police cases instituted within the district will be made and thereafter the cases will be forthwith sent to the magistrate concerned as per area (Police Station Wise).

Final forms submitted in individual cases will be filed directly in the respective court. The Ld. C.J.M. will exercise supervision and control to ensure that the G.R. register is properly maintained and case records are sent promptly to the magistrate concerned.

This new arrangement will come into force with immediate effect.
