Sub: Consideration of compensation in all pending cases in view of the mandate of directions passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in 'Nipun Saxena V. Union of India'

Respected Sir,

A matter is subjudice before the Hon'ble High Court, wherein it has been observed by the Hon'ble Mr. Justice Manoj Ohri that despite assurance given by the stake holders, yet there are cases under POCSO act where interim compensation/ compensation has not been paid to the victims till date. Accordingly, the undersigned would like to stress upon the importance of consideration of question of payment of interim compensation/compensation in each and every case. The mandate for payment of compensation by special courts is laid down under section 33(8) of POCSO act, Rule 9 of POCSO rules 2020 and the directions passed by the Hon'ble SC in Nipun Saxena v Union of India. As the Courts in Delhi are governed by DVC Scheme 2018 which is retrospective in operation, therefore it is incumbent upon the Courts to consider the question of compensation in every case.

Further, in W.P.(CRL.) 3244/2019, Mother Minor Victim 1 & 2 v. State & Ors. it was held by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi that the duty to award interim compensation in appropriate cases under POCSO is conferred on the Special Courts and it is not open for them to delegate this power to the concerned legal service authority. In Ankush Shivaji Gaikwad vs State Of Maharashtra, it was observed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court that there exists a mandatory duty on the Courts to apply its mind to the question of payment of compensation in every criminal case, i.e. by recording reasons for awarding/refusing compensation."

Therefore, in view of the above, it requested to your goodselves to circulate this letter to all the Ld. Judges presiding over the Special POCSO Courts and the other Courts as well, and issue a direction that to ensure that the question of payment of interim compensation/compensation is considered in all the pending cases.

It is further requested that the Ld. Judges be also directed to sift their Court data and draw a list of cases where the question of payment of compensation has not been considered till date and share the copy with the undersigned by 24.12.2021.
