It will also provide the facility to scan and convert the files in OCR format for differently abled or needy persons. In addition to that Hybrid Hearing Workstation is also available for litigants and Advocates to seamlessly attend court hearings at various court complexes from the e-Seva Kendra. Further, the e-Seva Kendra will also assist in providing information relating to pending court cases, status of orders/judgments, Judges on leave, e-Mulakat bookings in prisons, e-filing etc.
