In case any Judicial Officer is unable to perform the Duty work on a holiday or after Court hours, he/she shall make an alternate arrangement with his/her colleague at his/her own level with prior intimation to the undersigned and in any case Duty Magistrate happens to be on leave on a working day, the next Duty Magistrate will perform the duty work only during Court hours . It is further clarified that when any Judicial Officer, being the Duty Magistrate, has to proceed on casual leave or station leave, during his/her duty period, he has to obtain the consent from another Magistrate. If any Officer who is

Performing duty work in the last week of a month, happens to be on leave in a working day, the officer who is performing duty first in the current month, will perform the duty work during court hours. If on any working day, the Duty Magistrate is on leave or leave the station due to official tour/visit, his/her duty shall be performed by next Judicial Officer on duty and the intimation be sent to the undersigned. In case any Judicial Officer is on official tour on Sunday or on Holiday, the duty work shall be performed by next Judicial Officer on duty. The officer proceeding on official tour shall duly intimate in writing to the Learned Duty Magistrate in advance. If any of the officer is transferred during his/her duty period and some other officers joins at his/her place, then duty shall be deemed to be assigned to the newly transferred officers automatically.

**Note:- [1] It is further clarified that duty period for a particular day shall be upto beginning of the court hours on the next working day.**

**[2] The Magistrate on duty shall also perform the duty of protocol during his/her duty period under the supervision of undersigned/CJM.**


