- (ii) In case of any unavoidable circumstances, they are instructed to obtain the consent of the incharge presiding officer expressing his/her willingness to attend the duty of recording dying declarations.
- (iii) They shall not leave the Head Quarters unless the leave is granted.
- (iv) An appointed day for recording dying declarations commences at 6:00 AM and completes by 6.00 AM on the next day.
- (v) If an officer is on training or any leave the in charge officer to attend such duty.
