



CIRCULAR

Sub: Courts – Civil – M.V.O.Ps. - Investment of compensation amount awarded in M.V.O.P. cases – Certain instructions – Issued – Regarding.

Ref: Hon'ble High Court's circular ROC.No. 707/SO/2005, Dt.23-09-2005.

* * *

As per the Hon'ble High Court's circular instructions under reference cited, the amounts deposited into the court in M.V.O.P. cases are to be invested in Fixed Deposits within 15 days of its receipt.

To follow the instructions supra, it has become difficult to the Accounts branch to prepare note for making investment of amounts in M.V.O.P. cases due to non-receipt of statements from the concerned courts as to how much amount the claimant/petitioner is entitled to withdraw from the deposited amount and how much amount is to be kept in Fixed Deposit.

Hence, all the Additional District Judges in the Unit are requested to direct the concerned who are dealing with M.V.O.P. cases to put up detailed note before the respective Presiding Officer mentioning, entitlement to withdraw and portion to be invested separately in respect of each petitioner/claimant and then only send the same to the Accounts Section at an early date so as to enable the Principal/Additional District Court dealing with Civil Court Deposits to make timely investments.

These instructions should be followed scrupulously.
