## EXECUTION OF BAIL ORDERS

Mr. Gaurev Agrawal, learned Aminus Curiae has dramn our attention to order dated 29.11.2022 qua the issue of undertrial prisoners who continue to be in coustody despite having been granted the benefit of bail on account of their inability to fulfill the conditions. In this behalf the report by the MALSA has been placed before us filed on 38.61.2023. After recording the discussions which have been held, it has been stated in pura 5 of the report that there are 5,000 undertrial prisoners who were in jail, despite grant of hail, out of which, 2,357 persons were provided legal mesiatence and now 1,417 persons have since been released.

One of the main reasons flagged why the ecused are in juil despite the grant of hall is that he may be an accused in multiple cases and is apparently not silling to furnish bail bonds until he is given bail in all the cases as undertrial custody still be counted in all the cases.

Do hors this, it is pointed out that to ensure that the remaining undertrial prisoners who

)

are unable to furnish sursty or bail bonds due to poverty, NALSA is in the process of creating a master data of all euch undertrial prisoners in excel sheet with all relevant details, including, reasons for non-release and steps que persons who are unable to furnish bail bonds or surety are being taken up with the respective SLSAA/DLBAR and result would be obtainable in about one or two months' tips.

Learned Amicus Curise has also drawn our attention to the discussions with Shri Shashikant Sharms, HOD and Sr. Technical Director of NIC recording that five mootings were held along with the participation of Shri K.N. Nataraj, learned ASC and Model Ministry officials. A Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) has been prepared by MIC which also deals with this aspect. A relevant aspect is that the NIC e-prison software, which is working in about 1.388 jails in the country, would now have a field where the date of grant of bail would have to be entered by the jail authorities. If the accused is not released within seven days of the date of grant of bail, the e-prison software would automatically generate a flag/reminder and simultaneously the e-mail would be sent to the office of the concerned DESA so that the DESA can find out the reason for mon-release of the accused. The SOP has para 2.4 under the heading "Bailed out but not Released"

which facility enables prison user to access the data of invates, to assist in identifying invates who are bailed out but not released due to some reasons like sureties or pending cases.

Ineofar as the discussion with TISS is concerned, some suggestions are stated to be made but learned Amicus Curiae submits that a more detailed work out of that is necessary.

Another issue which has crept up during discussion is whether the Government would give access to this portal on a protected basis to the Scoretaries of the SLSAs and DLSAs which would facilitate better follow up.

We call upon the Government of India to discuss this issue with NALSA an that necessary directions, if any, can be passed. Learned ASS would obtain instructions in that behalf by the next date.

Mith a view to areliorate the problems a number of directions are sought. We have examined the directions which we reproduce hereinafter with ourtain modifications:

"i) The court which grants hail to an undertrial prisoner/convict would be required to send a soft copy of the bail order by enalt to the prisoner through the approximation of the convergence of the conv

2) If the accused is not released within a period of 7 days from the date of grant or bail, it would be the duty of the Superintendent of Jail to infrom the Secretary, DLSA who way depute para legal to Secretary, DLSA who way depute para legal content of the secretary of the se

a) NIC would make attempts to create necessary Tields in the e-prison software so that the date of grant of bail and date of release are entered by the Prison Oupertent and in case the prisoner is not released within 7 days, then an automatic consil can be sent to the Secretary, OLSA.

4) The Secretary, DLSA with a view to find out the economic empition of the accuse, say take halp of the Probation officers or the Para Legal Volunteers to officers or report on the socio-economic conditions of the insate which may be placed before the concerned Court with a request to relax the condition 19 of bail/verty.

5) In cases where the undertrial or convict requests that he can furnish bill bond or sureties come released, them in an appropriate case, the Court may consider granting temporary ball for a specified period to the accused so that he can furnish ball bond or sureties.

5) If the bail bonds are not furnished within one south from the date of grant bail, the concerned Court may suo moto take up the case and consider whether the conditions of bail require modification/ relaxation.

7) One of the reasons which delays the release of the accused/ convict is the insistence upon local surety. It is suggested that in such cases, the courts may not impose the condition of local surety."

We order that the aforesaid directions shall be

complied with.

IA No. 283407/2822-INTERVENTION, IA NO. 283408/2822-DIRECTIONS AND 21741/2823- EXEMPTION FROM FILING O.T

Application for exemption from filing 0.T. is allowed.

IA No. 203407/2022 and IA NO. 203408/2022 have been filed for intervention and appropriate directions by the National Law University, Delhi through Fair Trial Fellowship Programse under Project 30A.

We are of the view that instead of looking to the suggestions and directions sought, sors appropriate ourse of action would be for Shri Gaurav Agrawah, learned Amicus to look into them on behalf of the NALSA and accordingly make suggestions to us taking them as imputs.
