

1.	Compliance of orders dated 16.3.2021, 03.08.2021 and 16.11.2021 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India passed in WP(C) No.534/2020.	Compliance reports have been received from the Delhi Police, General Insurance Council and all the Motor Accident Claims Tribunals of Delhi. The Secretary General, GIC states that a consolidated list containing the generic e-mail IDs of each of the existing 14 Insurance Companies as well as the

contact details (i.e. names, addresses, mobile numbers and email IDs) of their respective Nodal Officers has already been sent to this Court as well as to the Delhi Police.

DCP (Legal Division) confirms the same and also supplements that the same has been forwarded to all the DCSP and Investigating Units of Delhi Police for necessary action.

The Gazette I branch shall also send such list to all the MACIs as well for their information and record.

It is, however, noticed that the E-mail IDs created by the Insurance Companies are not specific/ peculiar to the jurisdiction of each MACI. The Secretary General, CIC has stated that they will take up this issue with the Ld. Addl. Solicitor General and if required, seek suitable directions from the Hon'ble Supreme Court in this respect.

The Ld. Presiding Officers of the MACIs have already forwarded their dedicated/ Tribunal specific email IDs to this Court. A consolidated list of such E-mail IDs of all 16 MACIs be forwarded to DCP (Legal Division), Delhi Police as well as to the Secretary General, Central Insurance Council for their information and necessary action in compliance with the directions of Hon'ble Apex Court, who shall share the same with all concerned, and shall also ensure that the aforesaid E-mail IDs/ other details are displayed at the offices of the insurance companies and the police stations as well as on the websites of the insurance companies. Delhi Police may also display the same on its website.

Similarly, all the MACIs are requested to ensure that the aforesaid E-mail IDs are displayed at the notice boards of their respective courts as well as on the Court

website(s).

The Presiding Officers of MACTs state that all the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the aforesaid matter are being complied with/ will be complied with in true letter and spirit and all requisite steps will be taken without any delay.

Some of the Presiding Officers of MACTs have pointed out difficulties being faced in converting the 'current account' to 'savings bank account', due to banking protocols. The Presiding Officers of MACTs are, however, requested to take up the matter with the respective Banks, as per the specific mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and to send a report to this Court in this respect as well.

Mr. Arvind Shenoy, Advocate for GIC, has however informed that an application has already been filed in the Hon'ble Supreme Court for modification of the directions in respect of opening of savings bank account.

DCP (Legal Division), Delhi Police states that he has been appointed 'nodal officer' in the matter by the Commissioner of Police and undertakes that he shall, as and when called upon to do so by Hon'ble Supreme Court, submit status report before the Hon'ble Court.

The Secretary General, GIC and the DCP (Legal Division), Delhi Police submit that the aforesaid orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court have been communicated to respective Police Stations and the Insurance Companies. They again assure that all the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the aforesaid matter will be scrupulously complied with by the Delhi Police and all the Insurance Companies.

The Secretary General, GIC; DCI (Legal Division), Delhi Police and the Presiding Officers of the MACTs have been requested to send fresh compliance reports to this Court within five days.

The worthy Registrar General concluded the meeting while appreciating the cooperation extended by all concerned.


