This petition is filed by Advocate Thiru B. Ezhavarasu, u/s 439 Cr.P.C.,
praying to grant bail to the petitioner.

ORDER

Heard both sides. Perused the petition.

The petitioner/accused alleged to have been committed the offence u/s
341, 294(b), 324, 307 and 506(ii) of IPC.

The case of the prosecution is that on 12.04.2024 at 5.15 P.M. due to
previous enmity regarding the criminal case which is pending before the Judicial
Magistrate Court, Boothapandy, when the injured came near the Manathittal Petrol
Bulk in a two wheeler as a pillion rider, the accused attacked the injured with aruval,
caused injuries and also criminally intimidated him. Hence the charge.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case and the petitioner has been in judicial custody from 12.04.2024 and the petitioner is ready to abide by any condition and prayed for bail to the petitioner.

The learned Public Prosecutor opposed the application and submitted that the injured not discharged from the hospital and the investigation is not yet over.

Considering the objection of the learned Public Prosecutor that the injured not yet discharged from the hospital, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner/Accused at this stage. Hence this petition is dismissed.

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
