This petition is filed by Advocate Thiru N. Ratheesh, praying to relax the condition imposed on the petitioners previously.

ORDER

Heard both sides. Perused the petition.

Offence u/s 294(b), 323 and 506(ii) of IPC.

The petitioners were granted bail by the Principal Sessions Court, Kanniyakumari at Nagercoil on 02.04.2024 in CrI.M.P.No.1941/2024 with condition that they should appear and sign before the Judicial Magistrate, Valliyoor daily twice

at 10.30 A.M. and 5.00 P.M. until further orders.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners have been complying the condition regularly from 14.04.2024 and prayed that the condition may be relaxed.

Report received from the Judicial Magistrate, Valliyoor. A perusal of the report shows that though the petitioners have been complying the condition from 17.04.2024, they did not comply the condition regularly.

Considering the fact that the petitioners have not been complying the condition regularly, this court is not inclined to relax the condition.

In the result, this petition is dismissed.
