Government in its order No.LAW-LCL/148/2024 Dated 10-12-2024, has sanctioned two additional posts of Notaries to Madikeri Revenue Taluk and requested undersigned to in the letter No.LAW- LCL/001/2025 Dated 04-01-2025, to invite the applications from the eligible persons for appointment to the said posts of Notary, as per the Notaries Act 1956.

Applications (Memorials) are invited from eligible candidates for appointment of said 02 posts of Notaries sanctioned to the Revenue taluk of Madikeri.

## QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT AS A NOTARY

The applications (Memorials) shall be made to the Prl.District & Sessions Judge, Kodagu-Madikeri/ Presiding officer of the Court or Tribunal where the Advocate practices, the "Competent Authority" as notified by the State Government under Rule 4(1) of the Notaries Rules, 1956, in Form No.I as the case may be, prescribed under the said Rules. As on the date of application only such of those persons who possess the qualifications prescribed under Rule 3 of the said Rules and more particularly:-

(a) He/She had been practising at least for ten years as a legal practitioner or,

- (aa) A person belonging to Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other Backward classes had been practising at least for seven years or,
- (ab) A woman who had been practising at least for seven years as a legal practitioner, or
- (b) He had been a member of the Indian Legal Service under the Central government or,
- (c) He had been at least for ten years :
  - i) a member of Judicial Service or
  - held an office under the Central government or a State Government requiring special knowledge of law after enrolment as an advocate; or
  - iii) held an office in the department of Judge, Advocate General or in the legal department of the Armed forces need apply.

## APPLICATION FORM FOR APPOINMENT AS A NOTARY (Extract of Subrules (2) and (3) and Form-I is set out below for ready reference)

- 1) The Memorial shall be drawn by a person referred to in Clause (a) of rule 3 in accordance with Form-I (as per Rule 4(2) of Notaries (Amendment) Rules, 2024) and by a person referred to in Clauses (b) and (c) of the said rule in accordance with Form II.
- 2) The memorial of a person referred to in Clause (a) of rule 3 shall be signed by the applicant and shall be countersigned by the following persons:
  - a) a Magistrate;
  - b) a Manager of a Nationalised Bank;
  - c) a Merchant; and
- d) two prominent inhabitants of the local area within which the applicant intends to practice as a Notary. (designation seal and office seal of the above official should be affixed).
  - 3) The attested copies of the following documents should be enclosed with Memorial.

- Proof pertaining to date of birth (SSLC marks card).
- PAN Card
- · Graduation Degree certificate
- L.L.B Degree certificate
- · Certificate of enrolment issued by the Bar Council.
- Certificate (in original) from the Bar Association concerned showing experience of the applicant as a Lawyer.
- No objection certificate issued by the Bar Association of the concerned State needs to be submitted on selection as notary.
- · Don't leave any column unfilled.
- 4) The applications should also be enclosed a declaration regarding whether applicants are performing any duties under Rule 12 of the Karnataka Law Officers (Appointment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 1977.
- 5) The eligible persons may submit their applications/Memorials along with the attested copies of necessary documents as mentioned above to the office of Prl.District & Sessions Judge, Kodagu-Madikeri, before 5.00 P.M on 07.03.2025. If the last date fixed for the reciept of applications happens to be declared holiday, the next working day shall be the last date for receipt of applications.
