OFFICIAL MEMORANDUM

Sub : SNJPC – Issuance of directions to the retired Judicial Officers for submission of claims for arrears of Transfer Grant and Other Allowances - Reg

Ref: 1. G.O.(Ms.) No.66/2024/Home dated 04.03.2024

2.High Court Official Memorandum No. B1(A) 7898/2022 dated 4.5.2024

The Government as per order referred (1) above have granted the Judicial Officers the permission to draw arrears of transfer grant w.e.f. 1.1.2016 and accordingly, the High Court vide O.M. referred (2) above directed the Judicial Officers to submit their claims in the format appended therewith. Thereafter, as per O.M. referred (3) above, the Judicial Officers are directed to furnish their claims for arrears of transfer grant in the revised format issued alongwith it. In the circumstance, the retired Judicial Officers are also directed to prefer their claims, if any, for arrears of transfer grant in the revised format communicated vide High Court O.M. cited third.

The claim details shall invariably be verified by the DDO of the Court in which the Officer worked finally and the application be countersigned by the present District Judge concerned. While verifying the application, the DDO should collect necessary details from the relevant offices, if those claims are settled in other offices, in order to ascertain the accuracy of the claim. The duly attested revised authorisation slip shall

also be forwarded along with the application.

All applications submitted hitherto in format other than Appendix V(a) will stand closed and such officers are directed to prefer their claims afresh in the correct format.

Further, it is also reiterated that all the directions issued in connection with the submission of arrear claims as per the Government Order cited which are applicable to the serving Judicial Officers will apply mutatis mutandis to the retired Judicial Officers also and they can use the formats applicable to serving Judicial Officers for applying for the arrears. However, all such claims shall be countersigned by the District Judge concerned invariably.
