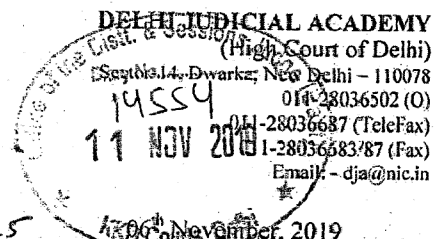

The nomination list of Judicial Officers for this programme is enclosed as *Annexure-A*. The tentative schedule of the programme is enclosed as *Annexure-B*.


