Tripura gets e-Sewa Kendra at the Court Complexes of Kanchanpur, Dharmanagar, and Kailashahar.



On 19 March 2022, Mr Justice S.
Talapatra, Judge and Chairperson,
Computer Committee, High Court of
Tripura and Mr Justice S.G.
Chattopadhyay, Portfolio Judge of
North Tripura and Unakoti Districts
inaugurated e-Sewa Kendra at the
Court complexes of Kanchanpur and
Dharmanagar under North Tripura

District and the Court complex of Kailashahar under Unakoti District. The judicial officers of North Tripura and Unakoti Districts, members of the Bar Associations, officials of the local civil and police administration, and the litigants participated in the inaugural function. Mr Justice S.G. Chattopadhyay emphasised the

importance of an e-Sewa Kendra the Help-Desk counter in a court complex, which is meant to serve the need of the Bar members, and litigants accessing various in information about the justice delivery system with the help of technology. Mr Justice S. Talapatra said that the setting up of e-Sewa Kendra is a milestone in the e-Courts project initiatives of the e-Committee. Court of India Supreme requested the Bar members and the litigants to avail

themselves of these services so that the e-Sewa Kendra may function with its aim to provide citizen-centric services. Along with the inauguration of the e-Sewa Kendra at these court complexes, VC Cabins were also inaugurated at the said Court Complexes. The Judges of the High Court of Tripura and the Judges were connected with the local prisons from the VC cabins via video conferencing, and virtual interaction of the Judges with the jailers took place.

# Workshop on objective accomplishment under e-Courts project Phase-II at High court of Tripura

On 17 March 2022, the High Court of Tripura has organised a Workshop cum Interaction programme on "Objective Accomplishments under e-Courts Project Phase-II" in the auditorium of the High Court for all the Nodal Officers, System Officers

and System Assistants working in the District Judiciary of Tripura for e-Courts Project implementation. Mr Justice Indrajit Mahanty the Chief Justice, High Court of Tripura inaugurated the said workshop, along with Mr Justice S. Talapatra, Judge and Chairperson, Computer Committee, High Court of Tripura. The Nodal Officers and the System Officers /System Assistants from all the 16 courts complexes of Tripura have participated in this workshop. This workshop discussed the achievement of targets so far and the completion of the e-Courts Project Phase-II targets in a time-bound

manner. In the workshop, the objective accomplishment report of the e-Courts Project Phase-II was discussed by the Central Project Coordinator, High Court of Tripura, through a PowerPoint presentation. An interaction session was also held with all the participants where issues raised by the participants regarding the difficulties they faced in implementing the e-Courts project in the District Judiciary were discussed.



### Migration of District court website from Drupal to accessible S3Waas platform- pilot testing at Sepahijala District, Tripura



As part of the eCommittee, Supreme Court of India's initiative to have accessible websites now the district court websites are being moved to a more accessible S3waas platform. The NIC e-Courts Division, Pune, the technical team of the Central Project Co-ordinator, High Court of Tripura started working on the website of the Court of the District & Sessions Judge, Sepahijala District, Tripura on a pilot basis for its conversion to S3WaaS Platform from the DRUPAL Platform and the said work was

executed within the short span of only two days.

The said new S3WaaS website of the District Judiciary of Sepahijala has been approved by the NIC, Pune this month itself after clearance of all audit objections by the High Court team. Now, the new website of the Sepahijala District Court on the S3WaaS Platform is ready for launching operational once the clearance is granted by e-Committee, Supreme Court of India.

e-filing station / Help desk at Sundargarh, Deogarh, Rourkela, Gajapathi Districts Court Complexes of Orissa



On 05 March 2022, Dr Justice S. Muralidhar, the Chief Justice High Court of Orissa inaugurated e-filing stations at District Court complexes of Sundargarh, Deogarh and Civil Court complex, Rourkela. In March 2022, Dr Justice S. Muralidhar inaugurated another e-filing station in

the District Court complex of Gajapati. Under the guidance of the e-Committee, Supreme Court of India, the High Court of Orissa has opened several e-Filing Stations / Helpdesks in various District and Subordinate Courts across Odisha to assist lawyers and litigants in e-filing their cases. E-filing stations/ help desks are equipped with high power scanners, all-in-one computers with two-way screens, accessibility to the internet and a dedicated operator trained in e-filing to provide e-filing related assistance to advocates and litigants.

#### e-Libraries for Advocates inaugurated at Orissa



On 22 March 2022, Dr Justice S. Muralidhar inaugurated e-Libraries for all the Bar Associations of Odisha and two outlying stations of Rourkela and Koraput. E-libraries will aid needy advocates practising in District and Subordinate Courts in conducting their legal research. Each of these e-Libraries has been equipped with desktop computers along with access to online law journals and is made available for use by advocates during working hours. The event was attended by the President of the Federation of Bar

Associations of the State of Odisha along with District Judges and office bearers of the District Bar Associations in virtual mode.

### Hands-on Training on e-filing for Advocates of Rourkela, Deogarh and Gajapati

Hands-on Training Programmes were held for lawyers of Deogarh and Rourkela on 05.03.2022 and lawyers of the district of Gajapati on 20.03.2022. Judicial Officer- Master Trainers travelled from various parts of the State to impart hands-on training on the usage of e-Services such as e-Filing, e-Payment of court fees etc., to trainee advocates of Rourkela, Deogarh and Gajapati.

The hands-on programmes for lawyers were inaugurated by Dr Justice S. Muralidhar, the Chief Justice High Court of Orissa. Fifty-nine advocates were imparted hands-on training in the training programmes held on 05.03.2022.

Thirty-two advocates were imparted hands-on training in the training programme conducted on 20.03.2022. Both the events were marked by the presence of Judges of the High Court of Orissa in virtual mode and members of the District Judiciary and Bar in Rourkela, Deogarh and Gajapati.

Uploading of Order/ Judgement from 01.01.2015 to 31.12.2020 in Darbhanga Bihar touches 99.30 %.





The percentage of order /judgement upload has touched 99.30% per cent. ICT Refresher Training for Judicial Officers in the Civil Court Bettiah, Bihar on CIS, NSTEP, JOAMS



A refresher training for Judicial Officers was organised on 06-03-2022 in the Civil Court Bettiah. This training program discussed many CIS modules, NSTEP (National Service and Tracking of Electronic Processes) and JOAMS (Judicial Officers Activity Monitoring System). The program's primary emphasis was "How a P.O. can monitor, regulate their Court and get a statistical

overview of their pending cases through CIS query and reporting tools". The options of the CIS old cases monitoring, order judgement uploading and IA filling are extensively discussed in this training. The process generation option and its publishing methods have been highly appreciated given their usefulness.

Online Knowledge Sharing programme for Master Trainers (Judicial Officer & Advocates) at District Courts of West Bengal.



On 9 March 2022, an online knowledge sharing programme on the topic of e-Court Services, e-filing, e-payment and other e-Courts applications was conducted under the supervision of the High Court at Calcutta by utilising the expertise of two Judicial Officer Master Trainers and two Advocate Master Trainers and AdvocateMaster Trainers in the State of West Bengal participated in

After successful completion of the (TOT) training programme, another training programme was conducted by the trained Judicial Officer Master Trainers and Advocate Master Trainers on the same topic on March 15, 2022, and in that training programme 485 Ld. Advocates of the District and Sub-divisional Courts in West Bengal participated.

High Court of Kerala rolls out the Paperless Courts in District Judiciary.



The paperless court concept for District Judiciary Implemented in two pilot locations by High Court of Kerala; one Judicial First Class Magistrate Court and one Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate Court identified by the High Court of Kerala. The project envisages covering all functionalities in a Magistrate Court in paperless mode. The repository of case documents is created by consuming

eFiled cases and scanning existing files. An online application is being developed by the NIC High Court Unit in coordination with the IT Directorate under the guidance of the High Court Computer Committee, which will cater to the needs of all stakeholders; such as Judges, Advocates, Police, Prison and Court Officials for managing the digitised documents. The integration of various applications like ICJS,

eFiling 3.0 etc can be done in order to accelerate the process of speedy disposal of cases in a paperless environment. User Dashboard for District Judiciary consisting of Judges

# High Court of Rajasthan replaces old laptops with 772 new laptops for Judicial Officers

e-Committee, Supreme Court of India sanctioned funds for procurement of new laptops for the Judicial Officers to whom earlier official Laptops were provided. After a due tender process, the work order was issued for the procurement of 772 Laptops for the Judicial Officers in November 2021 Allotment and distribution of new laptops for the

Judicial Officers have been completed in March 2022. Further, from the funds sanctioned by the e-Committee, procurement of an additional 243 laptops for the Judicial Officers is under process. These laptops are also to be provided against the replacement of old laptops.

# Absorption of existing contractual, technical manpower under E-Courts Project by High Court of Rajasthan

e-Committee, Supreme Court of India framed National Policy, under which, contractual, Technical Manpower was engaged with a clear stipulation that the technical manpower created under e-Courts project will be absorbed in the regular cadre of the courts and for which concerned State Government in consultation with the High Court would make appropriate provisions.

In terms of National Policy, Rajasthan High Court framed rules in consultation with State Government and vide notification dated 14.01.2022, amendments have been made in Rajasthan High Court Staff
Service Rules 2002 for recruitment,
appointment and posting on
"E-Courts Posts" for High Court as
well as for Subordinate Courts.

In view of newly inserted Rule 30-C of Rajasthan High Court Staff Service Rules, after the screening, existing 103 contractual, technical staff working under the e-Courts Project have been absorbed in the establishment of Rajasthan High Court in the first week of March 2022, against 308 posts of technical cadre sanctioned by the State Government.

# High Court of Punjab & Haryana creates 250 NICMEET VC account for its District Judiciary



For smooth functioning of video conferencing, 250 VC accounts of the Subordinate Courts in Punjab, Haryana and UT Chandigarh have been created on NICMEET software-based video conferencing in consultation with NIC Haryana.



National Judicial Data Grid (District and Taluka Courts of India)


To access the National Judicial Data Grid for District and Taluka Courts, one needs to click the "National Judicial Data Grid (District and Taluka Courts of India)" tab available on the left side corner of the NJDG home page. It will open up the NJDG for the District and Taluka Courts of India.



The coloured statistical bands display real-time statistics under various headings, such as Total No. of Civil Cases; Total No. of Criminal Cases; Total Cases of the Country; Civil Cases more than 1-year-old; Criminal Cases more than 1-year-old; and Total No. of cases more than 1-year-old.



The NJDG District and Taluka Courts of India home page also display a variety of statistics in five main tabs: (i) Drill Down; (ii) Pending Dashboard; (III) Disposed Dashboard; (iv) Alerts; and (v) Information Management. Under each of the tabs, a variety of options are bundled up which are discussed in elaborate separate headings



The home page also gives one the option of selecting the State and District from the drop-down list to get statistics the desired of any particular District. For example, when Andhra Pradesh is chosen in the State drop-down, the corresponding

Districts from Andhra Pradesh are displayed in the District drop-down, from where one can choose the required District and get the NJDG data for that particular District.
