The judicial officers shall pronounce judgments/orders in all such matters on the date fixed or maximum within a period of 2-3 weeks thereof, notwithstanding the posting/transfer. Date of pronouncement shall be notified in the cause list of the court to which the matter pertains as also of the court to which the judicial officer has been transferred and on the website.
3. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, (South) Saket, shall withdraw sufficient number of cases from the existing courts of Addl. District Judges and assign them to the newly created court of ADJ-05, South, so as to ensure equal pendency.

4. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, (East) KKD, shall withdraw sufficient number of cases from the existing courts of Addl. District Judges and assign them to the newly created court of ADJ-04, East, so as to ensure equal pendency.
5. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, (North-East) KKD, shall withdraw sufficient number of cases from the existing court of Addl. District Judges and assign them to the newly created court of ADJ-02, North East, so as to ensure equal pendency.
6. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, (Shahdara) KKD, shall withdraw sufficient number of cases from the existing courts of Addl. District Judges and assign them to the newly created court of ADJ-03, Shahdara, so as to ensure equal pendency.
7. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, (South) Saket, shall withdraw sufficient number of cases from the existing courts of Addl. Sessions Judges and assign them to the newly created court of ASJ-05, ASJ-06 and ASJ-07, South, so as to ensure equal pendency.
8. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, (East) KKD, shall withdraw sufficient number of cases from the existing courts of Addl. Sessions Judges and assign them to the newly created court of ASJ-07, East, so as to ensure equal pendency.
9. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, (North East) KKD, shall withdraw sufficient number of cases from the existing courts of Addl. Sessions Judges and assign them to the newly created court of ASJ-04, North East, so as to ensure equal pendency.
10. The Principal District & Sessions Judge, (South-East) Saket, shall withdraw sufficient number of cases from the existing courts of Addl. Sessions Judges and assign them to the newly created courts of ASJ-07, ASJ-08 and ASJ-09, South East, so as to ensure equal pendency.


