ORDER:-

NOTE:-

1. If in case of any urgency, any Judicial Magistrate on duty proceeds on leave during this period, he/she shall make an alternative arrangement for duty work in his/her absence and shall obtain the consent of the Officer in writing, under intimation to this office as well as ACJM, Panipat.
2. No Judicial Officer will be allowed to prefix or suffix any casual leave with the winter spell/holidays i.e. from 25.12.2024 to 01.01.2025.
3. The Officers performing duty during winter spell from **26.12.2024 to 31.12.2024** shall be allowed for special compensatory casual leave upto June, 2025 as per the instructions of the Hon'ble High Court issued on the subject. The officers who would perform duty during the prefix and suffix holidays i.e. 25.12.2024 and 01.01.2025 continuing with the winter spell shall not be entitled for special compensatory casual leave for these days.
4. The urgent criminal matters in any pending case relating to the Officer on duty shall be attended by the said Officer on duty, irrespective of the police stations.
5. All type of Civil matters instituted during the winter spell shall be put up before the Civil Judge (Sr. Division), Panipat, after winter spell for proper assignment.
6. If in case of any urgency, Sh.Sanjay, ACJ(SD)/SDJM, Samalkha proceeds on leave during the period of duty, the urgent cases (Civil and Criminal) pertaining to Sub Division Samalkha shall be put up at District Head-quarter, Panipat which shall be attended by Senior Judicial Magistrate on duty.
7. Protocol duty if any, shall be performed by the Senior Judicial Magistrate on duty.

2. No Judicial Officer will be allowed to prefix or suffix any casual leave with the winter spell/holidays i.e. from 25.12.2024 to 01.01.2025.
3. The Officer performing duty during winter spell from 26.12.2024 to 31.12.2024 shall be allowed for special compensatory casual leave upto June, 2025 as per the instructions of the Hon'ble High Court issued on the subject. Special compensatory casual leave for performing duty during the prefix and suffix holidays i.e. 25.12.2024 and 01.01.2025, would not be granted.
4. All type of Civil and Criminal matters instituted during the winter spell and remain pending shall be put up before the undersigned after winter spell for proper assignment.
5. If in case of any urgency, Judge on duty, proceeds on leave during the period of his duty, he shall make an alternative arrangement for duty work in his absence and shall obtain the consent of the Officer in writing, under intimation to this office.
