**AGENDA: Applications received from the Members seeking re-consideration of their declaration forms**


It is reported by the Nodal Officer that after publication of the supplementary list, three more applications have been received from the Advocate Members seeking inclusion of their name in the final voters list.

Office has put their declaration forms along with their applications for reconsideration before the Committee, which are now being decided :

Sl. no.	Name of the Member	Enrl. No.	Reason for filing application	Conclusion
1	Drishty Maan	D/1305/2018	An application has been filed wherein it has been submitted her name came in the objection list as Rs. 50/- was shown to have been due/pending as Member fee and she had claimed that she had paid an amount of Rs. 50/-.	The Committee has gone through the declaration form, and, it has been found that the dues of Rs. 150 were paid on 31.07.2024 and as per the list submitted by the RCBA, it was shown that the Member had not cleared her dues from her own account and, as such it is a clear violation of the judgment passed in <b>WP (C) 10363/2021 titled as Lalit Sharma &amp; Ors. v. Union of India &amp; Ors.</b> Furthermore, the Member has not filed any objection earlier within the stipulated period and even, after publication of the final voters list  The Committee is of the opinion that the name of Member <b>could not be incorporated</b> in the list of eligible voters for RCBA Elections, 2024 and, the application filed by the applicant is hereby <b>dismissed</b> .







2.	Mahesh Kumar	D/758/2009	An application has been filed wherein it has been submitted that though he was aware that his name appeared in the tentative voters list with objections, and, thereafter, he claimed that he contacted the concerned staff and was apprised that his objection of payment of dues has been cleared.	The Committee has gone through the declaration form, and, as per the list submitted by the RCBA, it was shown that the Member had not cleared his dues from his own account and, as such it is a clear violation of the judgment passed in <b>WP (C) 10363/2021 titled as Lalit Sharma &amp; Ors. v. Union of India &amp; Ors.</b> Furthermore, the Member has not even any objection earlier within the stipulated period and even, after publication of the final voters list  The Committee is of the opinion that the name of Member <b>could not be incorporated</b> in the list of eligible voters for RCBA Elections, 2024 and, the application filed by the applicant is hereby <b>dismissed</b> .
3	Rohit Tyagi	D/2793/2015	An application has been filed wherein it has been submitted that the Member had cleared his dues from his own bank account and has also submitted his bank account statement as well as receipt issued by RCBA.	The Committee has gone through the declaration form, and, it is found that the Member had earlier filed objection on 13.09.2024 with the Committee wherein he had categorically stated that " <b>I duly paid my dues amounting to Rs. 50/- from my associate, Aaditya Chopra's UPI ID</b> ".  Now, with this application, the Member has also filed his bank account statement for the amount of Rs. 2700/-.  The member had already annexed the receipt of Rs. 2700/- along with the objection form, however, the payment of Rs.2700/- was made on 27.07.2024 and subsequently, the payment of Rs. 50/- was made on 30.07.2024 from the other persons account, as mentioned herein above, which is a clear violation of the judgment passed in <b>WP (C) 10363/2021 titled as Lalit Sharma &amp; Ors. v. Union of India &amp; Ors.</b>  The Committee is of the opinion that the name of Member <b>could not be incorporated</b> in the list of eligible voters for RCBA Elections, 2024 and, the application filed by the applicant is hereby <b>dismissed</b> .

It is reported by the Nodal Officer that the second lot of 100 proximity cards have been received for distribution, which is annexed as **Annexure A**.


Let the same be distributed and necessary intimation in this regard be issued to the RCBA.

It is also reported by the Nodal Officer that many Advocate Members are approaching to collect the proximity cards of their known/relatives with one reason or the other, which is causing a hardship in distribution of the proximity cards. As per the directions of the Committee, the proximity cards are to be issued only to the Advocate/Members appearing in person against proper acknowledgment.




**It is once again clarified that this Committee will not entertain any such application/representation in this regard as has been decided earlier.**

Minutes of the meeting be uploaded on the Website of Rohini Courts, Delhi.


