The Advocates already registered in the e-filing 1.0 software can login in the link mentioned here-in-below with their mobile number or Bar registration number as their User ID. The password of their accounts is same as earlier used by them in e-filing 1.0.

In compliance to directions issued by the Hon'ble High Court and for smooth transition towards electronic mode of working in the Courts; all the Advocates are hereby required to electronically file the below mentioned category of cases at Panchkula Sessions Division w.e.f. **16.03.2024** online through E-filing portal i.e.

- 1. Bail Applications**
- 2. Petitions for Divorce by mutual consent(HMA 13B)**
- 3. Criminal Revision**
- 4. Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act**

The Advocates which are not yet registered on the above mentioned portal should get registered before electronically filing of cases. The link as well as the user manual of e-filing 3.0 has already been displayed on the website of this Sessions Division. The court fees, if any shall be deposited online in the module. Before, uploading, the Advocates/Advocate Clerks are required to convert the pleadings/document word file into searchable pdf file.

The hard copies of pleadings and documents should be submitted within 3 days of the E-filing of the petition at Judicial Suvidha Center; as the case will be listed for hearing only after filing of hard copies(as per E-filing guidelines received from Hon'ble High Court).
