

Shailendra Kumar Singh, Advocate enclosing copy of order dated 23.07.2018 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in WP(C) 7281 of 2018 titled as "Shailendra Kumar Singh v NDBA & Ors."	As directed by the Hon'ble Delhi High Court vide orders dated 23.07.2018 in WP(C) 7281 of 2018 titled as "Shailendra Kumar Singh v NDBA & Ors.", the Election Committee amends its observation making Sh. Shailendra Kumar Singh, Advocate "eligible to vote" in the NDBA Elections, 2018.
2.	Letters dated 27.07.2018 received on 28.07.2018 given by Sh. Devesh Vikram Shukla and Sh. Tarun Rana, Advocates seeking eligibility to vote in the NDBA Elections, 2018 on the parity of the order dated 23.07.2018 passed by the Hon'ble Delhi High Court in WP(C) 7281 of 2018 titled as "Shailendra Kumar Singh v NDBA & Ors."	Sh. Devesh Vikram Shukla and Sh. Tarun Rana, Advocates have relied on order dated 23.07.2018 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in WP(C) 7281 of 2018 titled as "Shailendra Kumar Singh v NDBA & Ors.", to seek eligibility to vote in NDBA Elections, 2018 on the grounds of parity. This Committee has perused the order passed by the Hon'ble Delhi High Court in the case of Shailendra Kumar Singh. The Hon'ble Delhi High Court has confined the order to the petitioner in that Writ Petition in the peculiar facts. Therefore, Sh. Devesh Vikram Shukla and Sh. Tarun Rana, Advocates cannot be declared eligible to vote on the parity of order passed by the Hon'ble High Court in the case of Shailendra Kumar Singh.

Ranbir Sharma, Advocate has requested that for voting in the forthcoming elections scheduled to be held on 31.08.2018, EVM machines be called for fair voting.




  

Chairman of the Election Committee.	The Committee has considered the letter and is of the opinion that the same is not subject matter of the Election Committee and decided to file the same.
4. Circular dated 25.07.2018 issued by Sh. S. C. Chawla, the Returning Officer.	Sh. S. C. Chawla, the Returning Officer has sent a copy of circular titled as "General Conduct" to the Chairman of Election Committee alongwith notification dated 24.07.2018 of the election schedule. It is mentioned in the circular that "No candidate shall permit its or his followers to make use of any government building including the building of Patiala House Courts and its premises or any individual lands, building, compound wall etc. for erecting flagstaff, suspending banners, pasting notices, writing slogans etc. " The Committee requests the Returning Officer to bring to the notice of all the members of NDBA the directions passed by the Hon'ble Delhi High Court in the case of Writ Petition (C) No.486/2018 titled as "Birender Sangwan v District Judge, North-West & Ors." dated 16.02.2018 where directions have been given that no candidate shall during elections deface any public property in any manner.


