NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers vested in them under Article 727 read with Article 235 of the Constitution of India and all other powers enabling them in this behalf, the Chief Justice and the Judges of the High Court of Himachal Pradesh are pleased to frame the following rules for the regulation and maintenance of Canteens in the precints of Judicial Courts in Himachal Pradesh:-

Short title and Commencement:

- (Regulation and Maintenance of Canteens" Rules, 1984.
 - (b) They shall come into force with immediate effect.

Definitions.

In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant of the subject or context:-

- Judicial Courts/complex.
- b) 'Chief Justice' means the Chief Justice of the High Court of Himachal Pradesh.
- c) Committee' means the Canteen Committee constituted under Rule 3 below.
- d) 'District and Sessions Judge' means the District of Sessions Judge of a Civil and Sessions Division.
- e) 'High Court' means the High Court of Himachal Pradesh.
- licence for running a canteen is granted under these rules.
- cer of the District or Block Medical Officer of the Division, as the case may be.
- h) 'Registrar' means the Registrar of the High Court
 of Himachal Pradesh and includes the Registrar
 (Vigilance).

Committee;

There shall be a committee known as the 'Canteen's Committee' consisting of the District and Sessions Judge, Addle District & Sessions Judge, if any, Senior Subordinate Judge-cum Chief Judicial Magistrate and it shall also include the Subordinate

Judge-cum-Judicial Magistrate of the Sub Division concerned in the precints of Sub Divisional Judicial Court.

Offers:

Offers in sealed covers shall be invited in the precibed form every year in the first week of March by the District: & Sessions Judge from parties interested in running the Canteen in a Judicial complex on licence. Notices inviting the offers within the stipulated period shall be displayed at conspicuous places such as the Notice Boards of the District Court, Local Municipal Office, Bus Stand etc. Every offerer shall be required to furnish a list of hot and cold beverages, and foodstuffs, which he is agreeable to serve, show-

Opening of offer covers:

ing the rates of each item.

A date shall be fixed by the Committee for opening the covers containing the offers and, on such date, of which due intimation will be given to the offers, the covers shall be opened by the District and Sessions Judge in the pre-ence of such members of the Committee who may be available and the parties, if any, present.

Grant of Licence:

(a) The Committee shall grant the licence of such an lefter whose offer is the most suitable keepting in view the

standing, experience, variety of services offered and rates there, for, etc.

(b). The process of granting the licence shall ordinarily be completed by 25th March every year.

Duration of the Licence:

7. The licence for running the canteen shall be granted ordinarily for a period of one year from 1st April to 31st March

Provided that the Committee may, in its discretion, for reasons to be recorded, grant licence for a shorter or a long er period.

Appeal:

An appeal shall lie to the Hon'ble the Chief Justice from the decision of the Committee in respect of all matters connected with the grant of licence and all other matters ancillary thereto within a period of 30 days from the date of order (the period taken for supplying a copy of the order from the date of application till date of supply of copy being excluded).

Provided that the Hon'ble the Chief Justice, in his discretion, may extend the period of limitation for filing an appeal in appropriate cases.

Security:

9. The licensee shall be required to deposit a security in the sum of Rs. 1000/- before occuping the canteen premises 292

pursuant to the grant of licence. The amount of such security shall be refundable to the licensee after adjustment of dues to wards licence ice, electricity and water charges, if any, and subject to the provisions contained in Rule 23.

Timings:

the line The canteen shall be kept open on every day by the licensee from 9 AM to 6 PM except on Sundays and gazetted sholidays for which it shall be discretionary for the licensee to do so unless otherwise directed by the Committee.

Workmen:

The licensee shall employ as many workmen for running the canteen as may be prescribed by the Comittee from time to time.

Service Conditions:

The service conditions of the workmen employed by the licensee shall be governed by the law for the time bealicein force governing such workmen failing which as the terms endiconditions which the Committee may prescribe from time to time.

The Committee may require the licensee to dispinserwith the services of any workman in case the District and Sessions Judge is satisfied, after holding such inquiry as may think proper, that such workman is unfit to be retaina workman for the canteen.

Antecendents:

13. The antecedents of every workman employed by the licensee shall be got verified by the licensee through the Police and such verification report(s) alongwith the photograph(s) of each one of them shall be submitted by the licensee to the District and Sessions Judge within ten days from the date of their employment.

Medical fitness certificate:

14. The licensee shall produce a medical fitness certificate in respect of himself as well as the workmen employed by him from the Medical Authority within 5 days from the date of grant of licence and/or the date of employment as the case may be.

Night Stay:

15. No member of the Canteen staff shall be allowed to stay for the night in the court premises without the express approval of the Committee.

Price List:

- 16. (a) The Committee shall, from time to time, prescribe the floor and ceiling price list for differenct varieties of hot and cold beverages and foodstuffs.
- (b) The price list as prescribed by the Committee shall be displayed at conspicuous place by the licensee.

miture etc.:

The canteen premises mall be furnished by the licisec before starting the canteen and crockery and cuttery shall
reprovided by him for customers as may be prescribed by the
formittee from time to time.

Quality of Foodstuffs etc.:

It shall be obligatory on the part of the licensee to prepare/serve hot and cold beverages and foodstuffs of good quality. The beverages and foodstuffs may be checked from time stortime by the member(s) of the Committee themselves or with the help of Food Inspector of the area.

Cleaniness:

The licensee shall maintain absolute cleaniness in and around the canteen premises all the time and shall keep the lutensils, crockery, cutlery, furniture etc. in hygienic and presentable condition.

Licence Fee:

The licence fee for the canteen premises shall be lecoverable from the licensee as per the assessment made from lines to time by the H.P.P.W.D. authorities.

later and Electricity Charges:

The licensee shall, in addition, pay the electricity diwater charges as per consumption.

Room Service:

22. The licensee shall provide room service to the officers in the complex on order.

Permission of 'Licence:

- the expiry of period by the District and Sessions Judge in consultation with the Committee on service of 24 hours' notice of by the licensee on giving one month's notice to the District & Sessions Judge.
 - (b) If the licensee terminates the licence at any time before the expiry of the full period of licence, except in the mode as provided herinabove, the amount of security shall be liable to be forfeited to the District and Sessions Judge concerned.

Vacation of premises:

On the termination of licence by afflux of time or otherwise, the licensee shall vacate the canteen premises forth with and not later than within 24 hours without any let or hindrance.

Residuary Powers of the Hon'ble the Chief Justice:

25. Nothing in these rules shall be deemed to affect the powers of the Hon'ble the Chief Justice to make such orders from time to time as he may deem fit in regard to all matter forming part of the subject matter of these rules and/or all 296
