

- 1: Public Holiday on account of Birthday of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar (April 14th) falls on Sunday.
- 2: Executive Holiday on account of Bengali New Year's Day (April 14th), Bhatridwitiya (November 3rd) & Jagaddhatri Puja (November, 10th) fall on Sunday and Chaitra Sankranti/ Baisakhi (April 13th) falls on Second Saturday.
- 3: Holidays on account of Muslim Festivals viz. Id-ul-Fitre, Id-uz-Zoha (Bakrid) and Muharram will be declared later on, depending on visibility of the moon, as desired by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta.
- 4: Sectional Holiday on account of Sab-E-Barat (February 26th) falls on Monday may be granted to Muslim Employees, Sectional holiday on account of Mahabir Jayanti (April 21st) falls on Sunday.
- 5: In accordance with Full Court resolution dated 06/08/1992, Second and Fourth Saturdays of the respective Calendar months have been declared as Court Holidays.
- 6: In accordance with Full Court resolution dated 01/12/2015, in the event of High Court declares as unscheduled Holiday, The Hon'ble The Chief Justice may exercise discretion to declare any "Non-working Day" as "Working Day" upon 07 (seven) days' notice, on consultation with Bar.
- 7: According to prevalent customs and in consultation with the local Bar Association, 1st April (Monday) and 27th August (Tuesday) are hereby declared as LOCAL HOLIDAYS on account of Easter Monday and Nanda Utsav respectively in the year 2024.
