- NOTE 2 : Executive holidays on account of Swami Vivekananda's birthday (January 12th) and Mahalaya (September 21st) fall on Sunday respectively.
- NOTE 3 : Holiday on account of Muslim Festivals viz. Eid-Ul- Fitr, Eid-Uz- Zoha (Bakrid) and Muharram will be declared later on, depending on visibility of the moon as desired by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta.
- NOTE 4 : Sectional Holiday on account of Sab-E-Barat (February 14th) falls of Friday may be granted to Muslim Employees.
- NOTE 5 : Sectional holiday on account of Mahabir Jayanti (April 10th) falls of Thursday may be granted to Jain Employees.
- NOTE 6 : In accordance with the Full Court resolution dated 06.08.1992 Second and Fourth Saturdays of the respective calendar months have been declared as Court holidays.
- NOTE 7 : In accordance with Full Court resolution dated 01.12.2015 in the event of High Court declares as Unscheduled holiday, The Hon'ble Chief Justice may exercise discretion to declare any "NON-WORKING DAY" AS "WORKING DAY" upon 07 (SEVEN) day's notice, on consultation with the Bar.
- NOTE 7: According to prevalent custom and in consultation with the Local Bar Association, 24.01.2025 & 21.04.2025 are declared as local holidays for the Judgeship of City Civil Court, Calcutta.
