Sealed tender in prescribed proforma from intending bidders are invited for sale of damaged/ broken wooden articles of this Court on "as is where is" basis lying in the District Court premises. The sealed Tenders will be received latest by 1.30 pm of 21.03.24 and will be opened at 4.30 P.M of 21.03.24 in the chamber of Registrar, Civil Courts, Cuttack in presence of the available Tenderers or their authorised agent. The Bidders should super-scribe the words "**OFFER FOR SALE OF DAMAGED/BROKEN WOODEN ARTICLES**" on the sealed cover.

All the damaged **DAMAGED/BROKEN WOODEN ARTICLES** will be sold to the highest bidder.

The bid price offered for damaged articles/ scraps shall not be less than the upset price fixed by the authority in Annexure-III. All bid offers must be accompanied by an **earnest money deposit of Rs.1,000/-** by way of Demand Draft favouring "**Registrar, Civil Courts, Cuttack**" payable at "Cuttack" otherwise bid offer shall be rejected.

The intending bidders may inspect all the damaged/broken wooden articles available for auction sale during the office hour either from 18.03.24 to 21.03.24 after taking prior permission of the concerned authority before submission of their tender papers. **TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR SALE OF DAMAGED/ BROKEN
WOODEN ARTICLES OF THIS COURT**

1. The Tender papers not sealed or received after due date and time will be summarily rejected.
2. The Bidders should super scribe the words "OFFER FOR SALE OF DAMAGED/BROKEN WOODEN ARTICLES" on the sealed cover.
3. All Bid Offers must be accompanied by an earnest money deposit (EMD) of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand) only by way of Demand Draft favouring "**Registrar, Civil Courts, Cuttack**" payable at "Cuttack" otherwise bid offer shall be rejected.
4. The sealed quotations should be submitted latest by 1.30 P.M of 21.03.24 addressed to the undersigned.
5. The received sealed tenders will be opened on 21.03.24 at 04.30 P.M in presence of the available tenderers or their authorised agents.
6. The intending bidders may inspect all the articles available for auction sale during the office hour from dtd. 18.03.24 to 21.03.24 after taking prior permission of the concerned authority before submission of their quotations.
7. The offered purchase price should be written clearly, both in figures and words.
8. The successful bidder shall deposit 25% of the bid amount in cash on the spot after completion of the bid and balance 75% of the bid amount by Cash/Demand Draft/Pay Order in favour of " The Registrar, Civil Courts, Cuttack" within 3 days from the date of finalisation of the bid in " Process Establishment Section, District Court, Cuttack ".

09. The GST amount shall also be deposited by successful bidder in shape of Challan and the challan receipt is to be submitted in the aforesaid section before removing the sold articles from the stipulated place. In case of non-payment of full amount within the stipulated time, the amount already deposited shall be forfeited and the aforesaid damaged articles/Scraps will be put to fresh auction.
10. The sold articles are to be removed from the site by the successful bidder within 03 days from the date of full payment.
11. The successful bidder shall take away the items on his own risk & cost and he shall be responsible for safe and appropriate disposal of the items. If any damage or otherwise is caused to the articles by any means during or after the stipulated period, no claim on this account will be entertained.
12. In case, the sold articles are not removed within the stipulated time, a ground rent @ 1% of the bid amount shall be charged per day till removal of the articles. Where the ground rate so charged exceeds the offered price deposited, the Bidder/party shall cease to have any right on the said articles. The amount deposited by the Bidder shall be adjusted towards the ground rent and the articles shall become absolute property of the Court free from all encumbrances and will be put to fresh auction.
13. The Court reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the offers of tenders without assigning reasons thereof.
14. No complaint or rejection, if any, after finalization of the Tender will be accepted.
15. In case of any dispute, the decision of the District Judge, Cuttack shall be final and binding on all parties.
