TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR SALE OF DAMAGED ARTICLES AS SCRAP

- 1. The Tenders not sealed or received after due date and time will be summarily rejected.
- 2. The Bidders should super scribe the words "OFFER FOR SALE OF DAMAGED ARTICLES AS SCRAP" on the sealed cover.
- 3. All Bid Offers must be accompanied by an earnest money deposit (EMD) of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand) only by way of Demand Draft favouring "Registrar, Civil Courts, Cuttack" payable at "Cuttack" otherwise bid offer shall be rejected.
- 4. The sealed tenders should be submitted latest by 11.00 AM of 20.04.24 addressed to the undersigned.
- 5. The received sealed tenders will be opened on 20.04.24 at 04.30 P.M in presence of the available tenderers or their authorised agents.
- 6. The intending bidders may inspect all the articles available for auction sale during the office hour from 12.04.24 to 20.04.24 after taking prior permission of the concerned authority before submission of their tender.
- 7. The offered purchase price should be written clearly, both in figures and words.
- 8. The successful bidder is liable to pay GST extra on the bidding , amount.

The successful bidder shall deposit 25% of the bid amount in cash on the spot after completion of the bid and balance 75% of the bid amount by Cash/Demand Draft/Pay Order in favour of "The Registrar, Civil Courts, Cuttack" within 3 days from the date of finalisation of the bid in "Process Establishment Section" of the Court.
