

CIRCULAR

In pursuance of direction contained in order dated 28.07.2022 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in Bail Application No. 3805/2021 in case titled 'Neetu Singh Vs. The State of NCT of Govt. of Delhi' and Minutes of Meeting dated 25.08.2022 of the concerned committee held in HQ, THC Delhi, it is hereby ordered that all the courts dealing with criminal jurisdiction viz., Sessions and Magisterial courts of North-West District shall forthwith transmit the data (soft copy & hard copy) i.e. the particulars of the persons declared Proclaimed Offender/Proclaimed Persons by them to the office of the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, North-West District and such data collected in the office of CMM shall be transmitted to NIC on weekly basis, followed by exercise of verification by NIC through Delhi Police, followed by uploading and updating the same on portal. As and when a Proclaimed Offender/Proclaimed Person ceases to be so, uploading/updating that information has also to be conveyed to the Office of Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, North-West District, Rohini Courts, Delhi by such court.



Compliance of order dated 28.07.2022 of the Hon'ble Single Judge of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in Bail Application No.3805/2021 case titled Neetu Singh vs. The State of NCT of Delhi	<p>The directions contained in order dated 28.07.2022 of Hon'ble Mr. Justice Talwant Singh in Bail Application No.3805/2021 in case titled as <i>Neetu Singh vs. The State of NCT of Government of Delhi</i> have been discussed at length threadbare.</p> <p>The Members present in the meeting have resolved that the data of Proclaimed Offenders/Proclaimed Persons already sent to Hon'ble High Court of Delhi by way of report No.1219/Rules/Gaz/2022 dated 13.07.2022 as well as further data collected</p>

in that regard shall be delivered to NIC within 03 days from today in soft form. Thereafter, NIC shall within one month prepare and launch a user-friendly portal, displaying the data so supplied. Before making the portal accessible to the general public, NIC will share the entire data of user-friendly portal with Delhi Police for verification, as to whether any of the Proclaimed Offender/Proclaimed Person has ceased to be so, consequent upon his/her surrender or arrest or death. After verification by Delhi Police, the data would be transmitted back to NIC, who shall then make the portal accessible to general public.

In the meantime, for the purposes of running data and further collection of data, a circular shall be issued by each learned Principal District & Sessions Judge, directing all Courts dealing with criminal jurisdiction viz., Courts of Sessions as well as courts of Magistrates to forthwith transmit to their respective CMMs, particulars of the persons declared Proclaimed Offender/ Proclaimed Persons by them and such data collected in CMM Office shall be transmitted to NIC on weekly basis, followed by exercise of verification by NIC through Delhi Police, followed by uploading and updating the same on portal. As and when a Proclaimed Offender/Proclaimed Person ceases to be so, uploading that information has also to be conveyed to the Office of CMM concerned by such Court.

In compliance with the directions of Hon'ble Single Judge that in the first phase, the data from the year 2000 has to be collected and uploaded, by the next meeting, some modalities for collation of data from Record Rooms shall be deliberated upon by all present, especially with regard to those cases which were consigned to Record Rooms after completion of trial of one or more of the accused persons in a case in which one or more accused persons were declared as Proclaimed Offender(s) /Proclaimed Person(s). One such modality of data collection can be constitution of a team consisting of one SJA assisted by two Head Constables in each district. But on this aspect, all present need some time to carry out deliberation.

It is agreed by all present to convene the next meeting on 07.09.2022.
