



1. The petitioner has preferred the present writ petition to seek the following reliefs:

"A. Allow the present writ petition.

B. Issue a writ in nature of mandamus or/and certiorari or any other appropriate writ making the system of Hybrid hearing as permanent system of hearing before this Hon'ble court and all its subordinate courts and tribunals.

C. Issue a writ in nature of mandamus or/and certiorari or any other appropriate writ by quashing the office order dated 11.02.2022 of this Hon'ble court.

D. Issue a writ in nature of mandamus or/and certiorari or any other appropriate writ by issuing necessary, ad-interim and urgent

directions/order harmonizing the office order dated 20.01.2022 of Hon'ble division bench of this court passed in W.P.2018/2021 titled as *Anil Kumar Hajelay and Ors. vs. Hon'ble high court of Delhi* and the office order of this Hon'ble court dated 11.02.2022 and also the circular dated 28.02.2022 by The Office of Principal District and Sessions Judge (HQs): Delhi.

- E. Issue a writ in nature of mandamus or/and certiorari or any other appropriate writ directing the central and state government to provide necessary infrastructure towards implementation of Hybrid courts in "letters and spirit".
- F. Issue a writ in nature of mandamus or/and certiorari or any other appropriate writ upholding the order dated 20.01.2022 of Hon'ble division bench of this court passed in W.P.2018/2021 titled as *Anil Kumar Hajelay and Ors. vs. Hon'ble high court of Delhi* and also circular dated 28.02.2022 by the Office of Principal District and Sessions Judge (HQ's): Delhi.
- G. Issue a writ in nature of mandamus or/and certiorari or any other appropriate writ by issuing detailed direction for the standard operating procedure for Hybrid functioning of this Hon'ble court and its subordinate District Courts and tribunals.
- H. Issue a writ in nature of mandamus or/and certiorari or any other appropriate writ by issuing training guidelines for all court staff/Judicial officers qua virtual/ hybrid hearings.."

2. Reliance was placed by the petitioner on Order dated 11.02.2022, passed by this Court in W.P.(C) 2018 of 2021, titled *Anil Kumar Hajelay & Ors. v. Hon'ble High Court of Delhi*, and the Circular dated 28.02.2022. It was pointed out that there is a discrepancy in the Order passed by this Court on the judicial side aforesaid and in the Office Order above referred.

3. The matter was adjourned and, in the meantime, the Full Court has considered the aforesaid aspects and resolved in its meeting held on

25.04.2022, as follows:

10.	<p>Additional Agenda Item: To consider the matter regarding permitting hybrid/video-conferencing hearings (on all Court working days) in the District Courts in Delhi where-ever a request to this effect is made by any of the parties and/or their counsel.</p>	<p>This matter has been taken up with the permission of the Chair.</p> <p>Considered. It is resolved that the District Courts in Delhi, shall permit hybrid/ video-conferencing hearing (on all Court working days) wherever a request to this effect is made by any of the parties and/ or their counsel, provided such a request is made in writing/through email at least one day in advance i.e. on the previous working day before 2.00 p.m. with a certificate/ declaration that an advance copy of such a request/ application has been served upon all the other counsels/ parties appearing in the matter.</p> <p>The Court may, however, fix a time slot for taking up all such matters where requests for hybrid/ video-conferencing hearing have been made or may take them up in such manner as such Court deems fit and information in this respect be displayed on the cause list(s)/ website.</p> <p>Further the Court may reject such a request for hybrid/ video-conferencing hearing where in the opinion of the Court the physical presence of the parties/ counsel in the Court is required or where the Court is otherwise of the opinion that the matter should be heard physically in the Court.</p> <p>Furthermore the Courts shall keep the video-conferencing link open/ live (with audio disabled) on every working day from the start of the</p>

		<p><i>Court functioning i.e. from 10.00 am till the Court holds its sitting; and the audio may be enabled only during actual hybrid/ video-conferencing hearings.</i></p> <p><i>The Principal District and Sessions Judges may be asked to furnish their views/ comments/ suggestions on the working of the aforesaid arrangement and the availability of adequate infrastructure for the same, by 27.05.2022.</i></p> <p><i>The decision taken in the Full Court dated 09.02.2022 in this respect stands modified to the aforesaid extent.</i></p> <p><i>Registry to take necessary steps.</i></p>

4. In terms of the said resolution, though belatedly, a Circular has been issued on 11.05.2022, bearing number 2552-64/DHC/Gaz/G-2/2022.
5. Since the Full Court has considered the matter in detail while passing the aforesaid resolution, we direct that the same be complied with by all the subordinate Courts. All the District and Sessions Judges shall ensure compliance with the Circular dated 11.05.2022 issued in terms of the aforesaid Full Court Resolution.
6. Adjourned to 26th July, 2022.
