Respected Sir,

May I bring to the kind notice of your goodself that Hon'ble High Court in <u>"Cri. Appeal No.352/2020"</u>, titled <u>"Karan Vs. State of NCT of Delhi"</u> and <u>"Cri. Appeal No.353/2020"</u>, titled <u>"Sunny Vs. State of NCT of Delhi"</u> vide judgment dated 27.11.2020 had directed all the Courts dealing with criminal trials to conduct an inquiry in all those cases wherein conviction of the accused put to trial is recorded to ascertain the quantum of compensation to be paid by the convict to the victim.

In this regard, number of directions have been given to the concerned, for the purposes of verifying the paying capacity of the convict and preparation of Victim Impact Report. An obligation is cast on District Legoi Services Authorities to assess the loss suffered by the victim and paying capacity of the accused

Full Bench of Hon'ble High Court in the said jutigment had also observed that for conducting this inquiry additional manpower would be required. While passing the order dated 27.11.2020, the Hon'ble Court had issued following directions:

"182. Delhi State Legal Services Authority is directed to prepare a proposal for additional manpower after examining number of summary inquiries that are likely to be conducted by DSLSA every month and the proposal be sent to Government of NCT of Delhi within one week whereupon Government of NCT of Delhi shall complete all necessary formalities within three weeks to ensure that the directions of this Court relating to the summary inquiry by DSLSA in every criminal case are implemented w.e.f. 02st January, 2021"
