Sir,

I am directed to inform you that Hon'ble the Chief Justice of India vide letter dated 3rd October, 2014, while expressing his concern about the large number of complaints received in the High Courts against the subordinate judiciary has opined that though some of these complaints may be genuine, a majority of them are made at the behest of those, within and outside the institution, who have vested interest with a personal agenda and keeping in view the objective of devising a procedure to be followed uniformly by all the High Courts to deal with such complaints, has issued the following guidelines:-

- A. The complaint making allegations against members of the Subordinate Judiciary in the States should not be entertained and no action should be taken thereon, unless it is accompanied by a duly sworn Affidavit and verifiable material to substantiate the allegations made therein.
- B. If action on such complaint meeting the above requirement is deemed necessary, authenticity of the complaint should be duly ascertained and further steps thereon should be taken only after satisfaction of the competent authority designated by the Chief Justice of the High Court.
- C. If the above requirements are not complied with, the complaint should be filed/ lodged without taking any steps thereon.

I am further directed to inform you that as desired by Hon'ble the Chief Justice of India to give wide publicity to the above guidelines, the same may be circulated amongst the Judicial Officers under your jurisdiction.
