CIRCULAR

Sub: Digitization/Sounning of record in Delhi District Courts.

The office of Ld. Principal District & Sessions Judge (HQs) has awarded a contract to digitize/scan 3,00,00,000 (3 Crore) pages till 31.03.2021 to M/s JiL Information Technology Ltd.

However, considering the time apan to complete the project by 31.03.2021, the office has to ensure that at-least 30,000 to 40,000 pages per district/per day be provided to the service provider so as to enable the agency to complete the project terget.

I am however directed to convey to your goodself that while monitoring the progress of digitization work the employees of the service provider agency, have highlighted certain issues which directly hampers their working, such as, insufficient working space, furniture and working hours (permission to work on holidays) etc. It has also been pointed out that sufficient number of files/documents with proper indexing is also not being made evallable to them on daily basis.

On the other hand, the court officials associated with the digitization process in various Judicial Districts have also pointed out that staff deployed by the vendor is not well versed with the process of digitization to be undertaken and thus a lot of difficulty is being faced by them in the entire process. The said issue(s) have been duly brought to the notice of the service provider agency and they have assured to take all remedial measures.

Thus, considering the overall facts and circumstances and to get the digitization process completed at the earliest, Ld. Officer in-Charges, Record Rooms (Civil/Criminal/Sessions) and learned-Chargersons, Digitization Committees of all Judicial Districts are requested to direct the concerned officers/official(e) to take up all the issues in regard to Digitization/Scanning of Records with the concerned Digitization Committees as have been constituted by Ld. Principa District & Sessions Judges in their respective districts, so as to resolve them at their own end. In case of inability to resolve the issues at their own end, the same may be referred to the office of Ld. District & Sessions Judge (HQs) duly accompanied with a report as to what steps were taken by the local administration to resolve the said issues. No communication without such a report will be entertained for further consideration by the office of Lc. District & Sessions Judge (HQ3).
