

Meetings and rallies are organised to highlight programmes under various Government which help SCs/ STs and weaker sections with particular emphasis on the distribution of surplus land to landless labourers. *sc/s*

23RD NOVEMBER (Sunday) CULTURAL UNITY DAY

24TH NOVEMBER (Monday) WOMEN'S DAY


